UNIVERSITY ARCHIVES

The collection contains a variety of print materials, photographs, ephemera, and posters describing a wide scope of university life. This includes Eastern Montana State Normal School Yearbooks, *The Retort: Student Newspaper*, admission publications, annual reports, meeting minutes, and newsletters from various committees and departments.

The *Montana Memory Project* houses several of our collections in a digital format all accessible through the Library's [Special Collections](#) webpage including:

- The EMC and MSUB General Bulletins from 1927-2015 and the EMC and MSUB Yearbooks from 1929-1972.
- The EMC and MSUB Photograph collection (1930-2016) contains 4,260 photographs of faculty, staff and students who have worked at or attended MSU Billings, various on-campus events, and campus buildings.
- The EMC and MSUB Posters collection contains posters from American Indian outreach, art, music, sports, theatre, and other campus events that have taken place at MSU Billings from 1972-2020.
