Hitter of the Week

Will Basom – Texas – Permian Basin

Junior, Lubbock, TX (Lubbock/Howard College)

In two game against #13 Abilene Christian University, Basom hit for a .500 average and then over .500 in four games over Texas A&M International for a final batting average of .515 for the season. Even more impressive than his batting average is that in this week of play Basom was charged with an error, only his third of the season, and struck out once, only the 11th in 163 at-bats.

Chris Solis – Incarnate Word

Junior, Catcher, Medina Valley (Medina Valley HS)

In the four games at Montana State / Billings , he batted 6-12 for .500 and raised his season BA by 5 points. Among his 6 hits were 4 doubles and 1 triple. he scored 6 times himself and had 2 RBI. He walked twice and had one stolen base. He threw out one of just three steal attempts against him.

Pitcher of the Week

Tommy Vrzal – St. Mary's

Senior, RHP, San Antonio, Texas

Vrzal saved his best performance of his Rattler career for his final home start as a Rattler. Vrzal tossed his first career no-hitter against Oklahoma Panhandle State on Saturday, allowing just three walks, while striking out nine against the Aggies. With the performance he lowered his ERA to 2.95. He is 8-1 in 13 appearances, including 12 starts and four complete games and one shutout. He has allowed 24 earned runs in 73.1 innings of work. He has walked 47 and struck out a team-high 73 this season. Opposing batters are hitting just .192 against him.
