# Opponent Information: Oklahoma Panhandle

Oklahoma Panhandle State has struggled in the early going reflecting a 3-13 overall record and a dismal 0-12 in Heartland Conference play. The Aggies are on a 12-game losing streak and have not won a game since they swept Hillside Baptist back on February 8.

Josh Garcia leads the Aggies with a .382 batting average. He has scored 10 runs and a team-leading 16 RBI for Oklahoma Panhandle. Garcia also leads the Aggies with seven doubles, and three home runs. K.D. Bressler has scored a team-leading 12 runs off a .315 batting average. Andres Belandria has been dangerous on the base paths, stealing nine bases off 10 attempts.

The Aggies have produced decent results at the plate but have been hindered by a weak pitching staff who have given up a combined 193 runs for an opponent runs per game average of 12.1. Jeremy Hingtgen leads the Aggies with a 9.26 ERA allowing 27 runs off 40 hits in 23.1 innings pitched. Although Kyle Cremers has struck out a team-leading 21 batters, he has allowed 52 runs off 53 hits for a 10.68 ERA.

#### Week in Review

The Jackets had a see-saw week on the road. After losing four-straight Heartland Conference games to league-leader St. Edward's University, the Yellowjackets rebounded to win four-straight over conference provisional member Texas-Permian Basin.

The Yellowjackets nearly handed the Hilltoppers their first conference loss of the season on March 1 in Austin, but a dropped fly ball in the seventh inning proved costly as the Jackets fell 6-5 in eight innings. The Jackets held a 2-1 lead in game two, but back-to-back Hilltopper triples in the sixth vaulted St. Edward's into the 5-2 lead and the win. The Yellowjackets were overpowered by the Toppers in the second-day series where they fell 10-2 in game one, and lost a 2-0 shutout in the late game.

In game one against the Falcons, the Yellowjackets made clutch plays when they needed them most. Rallying from a 5-0 deficit, the Jackets scored five runs in the sixth to eventually force the game into extra innings. A short single by Kyle Pryor plated Matt Schoonover for the winning run in the eleventh.

The Jackets' Brian Strom threw a complete game shutout in the Yellowjackets 9-0 win in game two. Willie Cratlic went 2-for-4 in the game with a double and two RBI.

The Yellowjackets complete the series sweep over the Falcons defeating them 4-3 in 12 innings before downing UTPB 7-2 in a darkness-shortened series finale. Jon Clark struck out a career-high seven batters in the win over the Falcons.

### In the Dugout

Good things are happening for the Yellowjackets as 16 different players either matched or broke personal career records in the games against St. Edward's and Permian Basin last week...MSUB is proving they have talent on the mound. Six different Yellowjackets have now pitched to a win with Ben Lewerke leading the team with a 2-1 record...the Yellowjackets also have done their work at the plate. The team has already hit six triples this season as compared to eight for the entire 2006 campaign...Seth Moir, a redshirt last season, has a team-leading five doubles.

Chris Brown is entering his second season at the helm of the Yellowjacket baseball program. In his first season, the team went 15-35 overall and 13-27 in the Heartland Conference. Brown was the head coach for two seasons at Bemidji State University, a Division II institution in Bemidji, MN, but left the Beavers immediately to begin recruiting at MSU-Billings. At Bemidji, Brown was the first coach in the program's 54 year history to post back-to-back seasons of more than 10 conference wins. Before he was promoted to head coach in the summer of 2002, Brown was an assistant coach at Bemidji State for two years. As an assistant he served as the team's recruiting coordinator and pitching coach. He spent one season as an assistant coach at Jamestown College (ND), where he was a pitcher for four years.
