This Week's Opponents:

Hawaii Pacific Sea Warriors – The Yellowjackets open the 2004 conference schedule with the Sea Warriors in Honolulu on Tuesday. Both games against HPU this week are scheduled to be played in the 7,500-seat Neal Blaisdell Arena.

While the Sea Warriors are off to a slow start with a 3-8 overall record entering this week, HPU has given the Yellowjackets fits over the past two seasons. HPU has won four of the last five meetings, including a 72-71 victory in Billings last year that snapped the Jackets' 38-game home winning streak, the longest in the nation at the time.

The game will feature two of the conference's top three scorers in HPU's Aaron Abrams (20.3 ppg) and MSUB's Trae Fortier (19.5 ppg). The Sea Warriors have three players averaging double figures, including Marvin Noble (18.5 ppg) and Albert Tecul (10.3 ppg). Noble is fourth in the PacWest for 3-pointers made per game (2.55), following the Jackets' Cameron Munoz (1st—4.25) and Dave Carse (3rd—2.62).

The Sea Warriors started the season with seven straight losses, but have won three of their last four. Six of their eight losses have been at the hands of teams that will likely be ranked in the West Region's top ten when the first poll comes out on Jan. 20 (Alaska-Anchorage, Hawaii-Hilo, BYU-Hawaii and Humboldt State).

Brigham Young University-Hawaii Seasideers – The Seasideers have as strong an argument as anyone to be the top ranked team in the West Region. BYUH is 10-2 with both losses coming on the road to Division I teams. The Seasideers, who were the top seed and host of last year's regional tournament, won their own Hawaii Surf-N-Slam Tournament at the end of December by defeating three DI teams (Baylor, Northern Illinois, and San Jose State). BYUH is also the only other team besides MSUB to defeat Humboldt State.

BYUH features the top scorer in the PacWest in Jake Chrisman, a 6-9 forward transfer from BYU-Provo. He is averaging 21.2 ppg game and has already been a two-time PacWest Player of the Week selection this season.

Four different Seasideers average double figures. Along with Chrisman. Shawn Oponui averages 18.6 ppg. Michael Stowell

Last Week's Highlights:

Cameron Munoz garnered PacWest Player of the Week honors for leading the Yellowjackets to two important West Region victories last week. The sophomore southpaw totaled 35 points and seven 3-pointers in the two games.

Munoz scored a team-high 18 points against the second-ranked Lumberjacks and was a perfect 9-of-9 from the free throw line. Six of his free throws came in the final 1:50 to seal the win. Dave Carse hit three of his five 3-pointers in the first half to keep the Yellowjackets close and also handed out five assists. Buddy Windy Boy scored a dozen points on 4-of-6 shooting from behind the arc.

Against Western Oregon, Munoz hit four 3-pointers and was 3-of-4 from the line in the final minutes to again seal the victory. He finished with 17 points, five assists and a career-high eight rebounds. Fortier netted 18 points and grabbed six rebounds against the Wolves and was 6-of-6 from the line. Dave Carse added seven points and five assists. Carse leads the PacWest at 4.88 apg.

Notes:

Entering the conference schedule, MSU-Billings leads the PacWest in scoring (87.4 ppg), free throw percentage (.761), 3-point field goal percentage (.439), assists per game (17.88), and 3-point field goals per game (11.62). The Yellowjackets ranked second in the nation last season for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point field goals per game (10.7).

Three Yellowjackets currently rank in the PacWest's top ten for scoring (Fortier, Munoz, and Skrifvars) with Carse at No. 13.

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
