## BYU-Hawaii's Chrisman Tops 2004 PacWest All-Conference Team Seasiders' Ken Wagner Earns Third-Straight Coach of the Year Award

BILLINGS, MT – BYU-Hawaii's Jake Chrisman (6'9" junior forward, Provo, UT) was selected as the Pacific West Conference Player of the Year in voting by the league's coaches today. Chrisman, who was also a Daktronics All-West Region first team selection, led the PacWest in scoring at 22.7 points per game and was a five-time player of the week selection. He also ranked in the conference's top ten for rebounding, field goal percentage and blocked shots.

Ken Wagner of BYU-Hawaii was named PacWest Coach of the Year for guiding the Seasiders to the Pacific West Conference Championship and the No. 2 seed at this week's NCAA West Region Tournament. Wagner led BYUH to a 22-5 regular season mark and is 272-134 in 14 seasons at BYU-Hawaii. This is his third-straight Coach of the Year award from the PacWest Conference.

Jason Jackson (6'2" guard, Albuquerque, NM) of Western New Mexico was voted the PacWest Freshman of the Year. He made 91 3-pointers and was second in the conference for 3-pointers per game and eleventh for scoring.

The PacWest Academic All-Conference team was headed by Jerett Skrifvars (Sr., 6-5 guard, Brea, CA) of MSU-Billings. Skrifvars, a 4.00 student in Information Systems, graduated Summa Cum Laude last May. He has also been named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America first team and was the only first team All-PacWest player also on the All-Academic team. MSU-Billings placed two student-athletes on the Academic team with Skrifvars and senior Dave Carse. BYU-Hawaii had three players qualify for the team, which requires at least a 3.30 cumulative GPA. Sophomore C.J. Fellars was the top Seasider with a 3.62. He was joined by senior Beau Nobmann and junior Spencer Lynn.
