This Week's Opponents:

<u>University of Hawaii at Hilo Vulcans</u> – The Vulcans were the preseason favorites to win the PacWest, and they were looking very much like the team to beat until they were upset at home by Hawaii Pacific on Saturday. After Hawaii-Hilo won two conference road games to start the season, they held the upper hand in a conference where road wins are hard to come by. After Saturday's home loss, the Vulcans will now be desperate to win at least once in Billings.

UHH is probably the most balanced offensive team in the conference, led by Ryan Abrahams's 17.9 ppg. Abrahams is the only returning All-PacWest first team selection in the conference. The Vulcans have four players ranked in the top 16 for scoring in the PacWest, with all four averaging double figures. They also feature the conference's top shot blocker in Joe Travis. As a team, UHH is second in the PacWest for defense, allowing just 69.9 ppg. That ranking will be tested by the Yellowjackets, who are first in the conference and fifteenth in the nation for scoring.

<u>Chaminade University Silverswords</u> – The Silverswords looked good in November, defeating Villanova at the Maui Invitational. However, they have only won two of their twelve games since playing giant killer, and both wins were against mediocre competition. Chaminade almost pulled off the upset of BYU-Hawaii last Thursday, losing by just four. The Swords then beat Southwestern College in Phoenix, 101-55, on Saturday. They will play two games at Western New Mexico this week before coming to Billings on Saturday.

The Silverswords are the worst offensive team in the conference, averaging just 64.3 ppg. Their leading scorer, Kashif Reyes, is scoring just ten points a game. Transfer Nick Frey is adding 9.2 points and 6.3 rebounds a game. He ranks sixth in the PacWest for rebounds and field goal percentage.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets' whole weekend was a highlight reel as they ran all over an overmatched Green Mountain College. MSUB scored 255 points in the two games, including 131 Saturday night. It was the tenth-highest point total in school history, but well short of the school record 146 they poured in against Western New Mexico last season.

Trae Fortier scored 28 points each night to improve his PacWest leading scoring average to 22.7 ppg. He posted double-doubles each night, grabbing 24 total rebounds to leap into the conference lead for rebounding at 7.9 rpg.

Cameron Munoz and Dave Carse combined for 25 of the Yellowjackets' 38 three-pointers for the weekend. Munoz made nine on Saturday, tying for the tenth highest single game total in school history. His personal career high is 12, which he reached at Western N.M. last year. Alex Galloway added five 3-pointers in Friday's win, scoring a career-high 18 points.

Career highs were the name of the game for the entire weekend. In all, eight of the nine Yellowjackets in uniform reached at least one career high. Jerett Skrifvars may have had the most impressive stat of the week, tying his career high of 12 rebounds in just 17 minutes of action on Saturday. He twisted his ankle just before halftime and sat out the entire second half so he would be healthy for this week's conference home opener. Skrifvars also netted 15 points in those 17 minutes for the double-double.

Along with Galloway, Buddy Windy Boy (21), Jonathan Wiley (7) and Matt Desin (3) also reached career highs for points scored.

Notes:

- * Jerett Skrifvars has 948 career points entering this week. He needs just 11 more to reach the school's all-time top 20, and 52 to become the 19th Yellowjacket to score at least 1,000 points.
- * With 13 games played and 14 remaining, Cameron Munoz has made 60 three-pointers. At his current pace, he could reach the top five in school history for 3-pointers in a season and 3-pointers in a career by then end of the regular season.

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
