This Week's Opponents:

Western New Mexico University Mustangs – The Mustangs are in last place in the PacWest, but have been close in three of their last four games. They knocked off Hawaii-Hilo on Saturday for their first conference win of the season. The victory improved the Mustangs' season record to 4-12 and their conference record to 1-5. They only won three games all of last season.

The No. 1 reason PacWest coaches take a wary approach to WNMU is the Mustangs' wide open offense. They are second in the PacWest for both 3-pointers made and 3-pointers attempted, firing up over 25 long balls each game. With two of the top nine 3-point shooters in the conference, the Mustangs are always just one hot hand away from upsetting anyone in the league.

Jason Jackson is second in the conference for 3-pointers made (3.69 per game), and Matt Enriquez is ninth (2.00). Enriquez is the Mustangs' leading scorer at 16.5 ppg, with Jackson close behind at 14.9 ppg. WNMU has three players averaging between seven and eight points a game.

- * The Yellowjackets set the single game school scoring record against the Mustangs last year, pouring in 146 in the second game at Billings. MSUB averaged 112 points a game against WNMU in four games last season, scoring over 100 points in 3 of the 4.
- * The Jackets have had better than average shooting nights in Silver City. Last year, Cameron Munoz made 12 three pointers and scored 36 points. Markus Hallgrimson set the NCAA Division II record with 16 threes against the Mustangs on their home floor in 2000. The Yellowjacket team record of 26 triples was set in Silver City in 1999.
- * MSU-Billings hasn't lost to WNMU since 1996. The Yellowjackets lost three of the first four meetings between the schools, but have won 18 in a row dating back to 1997.
- * Both of this week's games are scheduled to be broadcast on AM 970 KBUL, which will pick up WNMU's radio feed. They will also be streamed on the Yellowjackets' website.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets had a big week all around, jumping from fourth place to second place in the PacWest with three wins and debuting at No. 10 in the first West Region poll. With the release of the first regional poll, the race for the NCAA Tournament is officially on, and the Yellowjackets are in the thick of the hunt.

MSUB took two games from second place Hawaii-Hilo during the week, knocking the Vulcans down in the PacWest standings while moving the Jackets up. The first game was physical, with the Vulcans sending the Yellowjackets to the free throw line 56 times. They converted 44 to offset a relative lack of 3-pointers.

Even though the Jackets only made six 3-pointers on Tuesday, they more than made up for it on Thursday dropping in 17 on a Vulcans defense that couldn't find an answer for the barrage. Buddy Windy Boy made a career-high six 3-pointers and scored 21 points. Cameron Munoz made five 3's, and Dave Carse added four.

The Jackets were almost as good Saturday night, making 14 threes against Chaminade. Trae Fortier made a career-best five 3-pointers and matched his career high with 37 points. Fortier is ranked in the top ten in the PacWest in all nine of the major statistical categories and earned conference Player of the Week honors. Munoz made another five 3-pointers against Chaminade and leads the conference and the nation with 4.62 made threes a game.

Midway through the first half of Saturday's win, Jerett Skrifvars scored seven straight points to give the Jackets a double-digit lead. Those seven points also gave him 1,000 career points. He scored at least 20 points in every game last week and made 20 of 30 field goal attempts (66.7%). With that performance, Skrifvars now leads the PacWest for field goal percentage at 56.8 percent.

Notes:

- * Jerett Skrifvars became just the 19th Yellowjacket to score more than 1,000 career points on Saturday. He needs three points to catch Troy Truvillion for No. 18 in school history, and 28 to catch Jeff Andrade for No. 17.
- * Three more made free throws will move Skrifvars into fourth place in school history for free throws made in a career.
- * Dave Carse's next 3-pointer will tie him for seventh all-time with Chris Herriford at 154.
- * Cameron Munoz needs 25 more 3-pointers to move into the top five in school history for career threes.

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
