Thursday, Feb. 5 – vs. Great Falls (7 p.m., Alterowitz Gym)

This Week's Opponent:

University of Great Falls Argonauts – The Argos weren't very good when they lost to the Yellowjackets by 45 on December 1. James Edwards was the only player to score in double figures in that meeting, finishing with a double-double of 16 points and 11 rebounds.

The Argos shot just 27 percent from the field and were 0 of 7 from 3-point range in the game. They did manage to get to the free throw line 35 times, sinking 77 percent of their tries for 27 of their 63 points.

The Yellowjackets made twice as many field goals (36-18) and dropped in twelve 3-pointers. Cameron Munoz and Dave Carse accounted for 11 of those threes.

The Argos won three of their next five games after leaving Billings, but have lost seven in a row entering this week. They played fairly close to the top two teams in the Frontier a couple weeks ago, losing to UM-Western by eight and to Rocky Mountain by 13.

Last weekend, Great Falls dropped back-to-back games at Lewis-Clark State and Westminster by a combined score of 143-96. The Argos scored just 37 points in the loss to Westminster on Saturday. They enter this week with a 6-16 overall record.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets had a disappointing week with two losses at Western New Mexico. MSU-Billings was ranked No. 8 in last week's West Region poll, but will most likely drop out of the top ten this week with the losses in Silver City. The top eight teams in the final regional poll qualify for the NCAA Tournament.

Cameron Munoz scored over 20 points each night against the Mustangs, netting 23 and 28. He made twelve 3-pointers in the two games to increase his conference- and nation-leading average to 4.78 made 3-pointers per game. He was 7 of 15 from behind the arc on Saturday, scoring 28 of the Jackets' 77 points.

Trae Fortier scored 28 in Thursday's loss, and added 19 on Saturday. He also grabbed ten rebounds Saturday for his sixth double-double of the season, which leads the PacWest. Jerett Skrifvars is second in the conference with four double-doubles.

The Yellowjackets entered the week ranked No. 12 in the nation for team free throw percentage, but poor foul shooting was a major factor on Saturday. MSUB shot just 57 percent from the charity stripe, connecting on 12 of 21 attempts.

The free throw line wasn't the only place the Jackets were cold on Saturday. They had their second-worst shooting night of the season from the field, hitting just 36.6 percent of their shots.

* Jerett Skrifvars moved up to No. 18 in school history for career scoring with 22 points last weekend. He needs six points to tie Jeff Andrade for No. 17 and 13 points to tie Kas Ioane for No. 16.

* Skrifvars is also 35 rebounds short of tying Doug Borland for No. 10 all time for career rebounds.

* Cameron Munoz needs eighteen 3-pointers to become just the fifth Yellowjacket to make 200 threes in his career.

*Following Thursday's game with Great Falls, the Yellowjackets enter the stretch run of their PacWest schedule. They will host 18th-ranked BYU-Hawaii for two big games on February 10 and 12, and Hawaii Pacific on February 14.

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
