This Week's Opponent:

<u>Chaminade University Silverswords</u> – The Silverswords were idle last week and will enter this week with a 6-12 overall record and a 3-5 conference mark. They have won four of their last six games, with one of their losses coming to the Yellowjackets two weeks ago in Billings.

The Silverswords' will probably try to slow the game down against the Yellowjackets even though MSUB will be shorthanded again. Chaminade has only scored over 80 points three times this year.

Kashif Reyes averages 11.2 points per game for the Swords, and Nick Frey adds 10.1 points a night. Reyes, Frey and Roy Stigall (9 ppg) can all score over 20 on any given night, but they have also had games where they haven't scored at all.

University of Hawaii-Hilo Vulcans – The Vulcans went from league favorite to middle of the pack during a five-game slide that started with two losses in Billings at the end of January. The frustrated Vulcans piled up ejections and technical fouls during the two games in Billings and will no doubt be looking for revenge when the Jackets come to town on Saturday. Hawaii-Hilo bounced back with a home win against BYU-Hawaii in its last game on February 3.

Ryan Abrahams leads the Vulcans in scoring at 18.4 points per game. Big man Joe Travis averages 13.6 points and 7.4 rebounds a game, and Justin Griffin adds 11.4 points a night.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets won two of three games at home last week, splitting with 17th-ranked BYU-Hawaii and running past Hawaii Pacific. The Thursday loss against the Seasiders ended the Jackets' 23 game home winning streak, the fourth longest in the nation at the time.

But the most damaging event of the week was the injury of sophomore guard Cameron Munoz. Munoz was injured in the final minute of the win against BYUH on Tuesday and missed the rest of the week. The national leader in 3-point shooting, Munoz isn't expected to play this week in Hawaii either.

Senior Jerett Skrifvars had a big week, averaging 26 points and ten rebounds a game with two double-doubles. He now leads the PacWest Conference with seven double-doubles, one ahead of teammate Trae Fortier. Skrifvars scored a career-high 31 on Tuesday, lifting the Yellowjackets to an important win over the No. 2 team in the West Region.

Fortier averaged 20 points a game in two games, including 25 against HPU. Buddy Windy Boy and Dave Carse combined for 23 3-pointers over the three games, with Carse knocking down 13. He made a career-high seven in the win against Hawaii Pacific. Carse averaged 16 points a game for the week, and Windy Boy added 15 a night.

- * Dave Carse moved into the top five in school history for career assists with 409. He is six short of Willy Davison for No. 4 and 42 short of Tom Osborne for No. 3

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
