Last Week's Highlights:
 The Yellowjackets pulled out another exciting win at Alterowitz last week, downing St. Martin's 93-86 on Saturday night. Three of the four wins at home this season have come down to the last minute of the game, due mostly to the fact that Chadron State, Minot State and St. Martin's are all much improved over last season.

Cameron Munoz continued to have the hot shooting hand against St. Martin's, dropping in seven 3-pointers for a game-high 27 points. He was 9-of-15 from the field and 7-of-11 from 3-point range. The long range specialist still leads the PacWest for overall field goal percentage (61.5), 3-point percentage (57.4) and 3-pointers per game (4.5).

Trae Fortier netted 22 against the Saints on 9-of-15 shooting from the field. His 20.7 points per game average is second in the PacWest.

Jerett Skrifvars added 16 points and seven assists. He also pulled down 11 rebounds for his third double-double of the season. Skrifvars connected on 10-of-12 from the free throw line, giving him 352 made free throws in his career, fifth all-time in school history. His 16 points moved his career total to 864. He is now 95 points from cracking the school's top 20 scoring list. At his current 16 ppg pace, Skrifvars could catch Wayne Boyd for No. 20 during the two-game home stand with Green Mountain in the middle of January.

Dave Carse chipped in eight points and eight assists in the win against St. Martin's. He is now alone in seventh place all-time for career assists and will be chasing Billy Foster's 408 assists to reach the top five all-time.

The Jackets opened the week with a tough road loss against a very good Western Oregon team on Tuesday. MSUB's only two losses this season have come on the road to the top two teams in the GNAC.

Last Week's Highlights continued:

The Yellowjackets held a five-point halftime lead and were tied with the Wolves in the final minutes in Monmouth, but committed two costly turnovers. Western then hit two free throws with less than two seconds on the clock for the final margin.

Trae Fortier scored 20 of his career-high 35 points in the second half, including the Yellowjackets' final 11 points of the game. He was a nearly unstoppable 14-of-21 from the field (66.7%) and hit 4-of-7 from behind the arc.

As a team, the Yellowjackets made eleven 3-pointers in the game and are averaging 11.7 per game this season. Bemidji State, who edged the Jackets for last year's national 3-point title (11.7 to 10.7 per game) is currently averaging 10.2 per game. The first official NCAA statistical report of the season will be released the week of January 5.

Munoz, Skrifvars and Carse all netted double figures against the Wolves, finishing with 15, 13, and 12 points respectively. Skrifvars and Carse also combined for a dozen assists. The senior captains are currently 1-2 in the PacWest for assists per game. Skrifvars leads the league with 5.50 per game while Carse is second at 4.83.

With the win, the Wolves moved to 7-2 with one of their losses coming at BYU-Provo. The two teams that have beaten the Yellowjackets this season are a combined 16-3 overall and a combined 11-0 on their home courts.

Notes:

The Yellowjackets will put their 14-game home winning streak on the line next week against two of the best teams in the West Region. Second-ranked Humboldt State visits Alterowitz on December 29 and Western Oregon comes to town on January 3.

The Jackets' home winning streak of 14 is tied for the seventh longest current streak in Division II. Henderson State has also won 14-straight at home. District of Columbia holds the nation's longest home winning streak at 25, followed by South Dakota State with 24, Nebraska-Kearney with 23, Northwest Missouri State with 23, Cal State-San Bernardino with 22 and Florida Gulf Coast with 21.

MSU-Billings will open the 2004 Pacific West Conference schedule on January 6 and 8 at Hawaii Pacific and January 10 at BYU-Hawaii. The Yellowjackets' conference home opener will be January 20 against Hawaii-Hilo.

Senior guard Justin Hassell underwent successful back surgery last week. He will be lost for the remainder of the season while rehabilitating a back injury that has required two back surgeries in the last four years.

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
