## This Week's Opponents:

<u>Humboldt State University Lumberjacks</u> – The Lumberjacks were the consensus preseason No. 1 team in the nation and have built a 9-1 record over the first month of the season. HSU dropped to No. 2 in the NABC poll after losing at BYU-Hawaii at the end of November, the Jacks' only stumble in ten games. BYU-Hawaii has been impossible to beat at home this year, following its upset of Humboldt State with wins over three Division I teams.

Humboldt is led by a pair of All-Americans in Austin Nichols and Fred Hooks. The two seniors are No. 5 and No. 10 respectively in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference for scoring. Nichols (6-6 forward, Berkeley, CA) is averaging 20.8 points per game while Hooks (6-6 forward, San Diego, CA) is netting 16.2 a game. Hooks's 9.3 rebounds per game ranks third in the GNAC.

Freshman Kejuan Johnson (6-3 guard, Lakewood, CA) is adding 12.9 points a game while senior Mark White (6-2 guard, Bozeman, MT) averages 9.1 points and 7.2 assists per game, ranking him second in the conference for assists.

The Lumberjacks defeated Chico State (95-78) and Sonoma State (88-71) in a pre-holiday tournament last week. Their game at Alterowitz will be just their fourth game of the season away from their home court in Arcata.

Humboldt handed the Yellowjackets their first loss of the season on December 13 when the Lumberjacks defeated MSUB 104-76 in Arcata. Nichols scored a game-high 21, and Johnson and Trey Shannon (6-6 Sr. forward, Yuba City, CA) each added 17.

<u>Western Oregon University Wolves</u> – The Wolves were picked second in the GNAC behind Humboldt State and are 7-2 entering this week. Their last game was a 94-88 win over the Jackets in Monmouth on December 16. WOU will host its own two-day tournament on Monday and Tuesday, facing Southern Oregon and Florida Southern before flying to Billings

Robert Day (6-5 Sr. guard, Portland, OR) leads the Wolves and is second in the GNAC for scoring at 22.6 ppg. Sean Kelly (6-5 Sr. forward, Grand Junction, CO) is second on the team and fourth in the conference, averaging 21.4 ppg. The Yellowjackets had trouble stopping both players two weeks ago in Monmouth.

The Yellowjackets and Wolves were a combined 20-of-43 from behind the arc in their last meeting. MSUB finished with 11 long balls and the Wolves added nine.

# 2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

**Craig Carse (9<sup>th</sup> year):** Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

**Mark Hamilton (1<sup>st</sup> year):** Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10<sup>th</sup> at 17.9), field goals made (6<sup>th</sup> with 496), and three-point percentage (4<sup>th</sup> at 42.56).
