This Week's Opponents:

Green Mountain College Eagles – The Eagles enter the week with a 3-9 overall record having lost their last five games. They will play at College of St. Joseph—whom they have beaten twice—on Tuesday before flying to Billings for a pair of weekend games.

Green Mountain is a former NAIA school reclassifying to NCAA Division II. Located in Poultney, VT, they are currently playing as a DII independent.

No statistics are available for the Eagles. Their three wins have been against Paul Smith's College, and College of St. Joseph twice. In their last five losses, the Eagles have been outscored by an average of 104.6 to 70. They have given up over 100 points in five of their 12 games entering this week, including 119 to Teikyo Post, the eighth highest total in Division II this season.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets picked up one big conference win in Hawaii last week and had a second victory slip out of their hands in the final seconds.

On Tuesday, the Yellowjackets lost to a red-hot Hawaii Pacific team that shot 70-percent from 3-point range and made a school record 19 threes. Coach Carse said afterword that he didn't think anyone in the region could have beaten the Sea Warriors that night. Despite HPU'shot shooting, Trae Fortier kept the Jackets in the game, scoring a career-high 37 points and grabbing a career-high 13 rebounds. Cameron Munoz hit five 3-pointers for 15 points, and Dave Carse added 20 points and five assists.

Jerett Skrifvars returned from his ankle injury to lead the Yellowjackets to their win over HPU on Thursday. He scored 23 points, connecting on 11-of-16 attempts from the field. Fortier had another double-double with 21 points and ten boards. Munoz hit four 3-pointers and scored 20 points.

Yellowjackets on the Airwaves

The Yellowjackets had first place BYU-Hawaii on the ropes Saturday night before the Seasiders hit a shot from the corner in the waning seconds to steal the win. Skrifvars had given the Jackets a 90-89 lead with 20.6 seconds to play, scoring on a drive to the basket, drawing the foul and converting the three point play. The Yellowjackets nearly forced a turnover on the next possession, but the Seasiders retained possession and were able to hit the game winning shot with six seconds remaining. Cameron Munoz had a shot in traffic to win it in the final seconds, but just missed. Bill Day had a brief chance at a tip in, but also missed.

BYU-Hawaii is 11-0 at home this season. The Yellowjackets would have been the first Division II team to beat the Seasiders, whose two losses have been on the road to two DI teams. Three of BYUH's eleven home wins have been against DI teams, and another was against Humboldt State. MSU-Billings will get two shots at the Seasiders in Billings in February.

Notes:

- * MSU-Billings was 0-6 in Hawaii last year, costing them a shot at the conference championship. In the Yellowjackets' last PacWest championship season (2001-02), they were 1-5 on the islands. By coming away from the first Hawaii trip at 1-2, MSUB has positioned itselft for a run at the PacWest title. In February, the Yellowjackets will play twice at Chaminade and once at UH-Hilo.
- * Through games of January 4, the Yellowjackets rank in the nation's top 20 in four statistical categories. Traditionally one of the top scoring and 3-point shooting teams in NCAA Division II, MSU-Billings is ranked third for 3-pointers per game (11.6) and 19th for scoring (87.4 ppg) in the NCAA's first statistical ranking summary of 2004. Updated statistical rankings are posted each week on the NCAA website (www.ncaa.org).
- * Cameron Munoz is tied for first in the nation for 3-point field goals per game (4.3) and is fourth for 3-point field goal percentage (51.5) through the January 4 rankings.
- * Trae Fortier leads the PacWest in scoring following his big week in Hawaii. He averaged 27.7 points and 9.7 rebounds in his first three PacWest Conference games. His 37 points against Hawaii Pacific were the second most scored in a single game by anyone in the conference this season. He has two of the top three scoring games, including the 35 he scored at Western Oregon in December.
- * A sample of the PacWest statistical rankings are in the box to the right. Most statistical categories are listed as are any Yellowjackets ranked in the top ten in the conference. For the complete conference statistical rankings as well as updated results and stats, visit the PacWest Conference's website at www.gopacwest.org.
- * Jerett Skrifvars has 919 career points entering this week. He needs just 40 more to reach the school's all-time top 20, and 81 to become the 19th Yellowjacket to score at least 1,000 points.

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
