This Week's Opponents:

Brigham Young University-Hawaii – The Seasiders have had an up and down season already. After starting 5-1 and climbing to a No. 9 national ranking, they dropped three straight nonconference games to fall to 5-4. BYUH has rebounded from the three straight losses with back-to-back conference wins. The Seasiders won in two heart-stoppers, defeating Hawaii Pacific and Hawaii-Hilo on last second shots.

The Seasiders have eight players averaging double-digit minutes and three players averaging over 13 points a game. Reigning PacWest Player of the Year Jake Chrisman leads the team at 18.5 points per game after a slow start to the year. He scored 31 in the win over UHH last week. Big man Austin Smylie is adding 16.5 points and 7.2 rebounds a game, and Michael Stowell is averaging 13.6 points.

<u>Hawaii Pacific University</u> – The Sea Warriors have lost three of their last four, all conference games. They defeated Chaminade, 121-119 in triple overtime last week. HPU plays once at Western New Mexico before traveling to Billings for two games.

Dante Sykes leads four players who are averaging double figures. Sykes is scoring 14.9 points a game and is second on the team at 6.9 rebounds a game. Gene Barnes is adding 11.4 points a game and leads the team with 22 3-pointers.

Audrius Peciukas averages 11.1 points and leads the conference at 8.5 rebounds per game. Aleksander Bojic is adding 10.3 points and 4.2 rebounds a game.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Montana State-Billings men's basketball team filled its off weekend with a 116-99 win in its annual alumni game.

The two teams combined to make 37 3-pointers. Buddy Windy Boy led all players with 31 points and nine threes. The Yellowjackets made 23 3-pointers as a team. Carlin Hughes made five and finished with 24 points. Jay Jamieson knocked down four triples and netted 18 points.

Five Yellowjackets finished in double figures for scoring. Lucas Walker scored 25 points, hitting three 3-pointers. Senior Justin Hassell added 17 points.

The MSU-Billings alumni team was led by 30 points from Mark Hamilton. The 1998 graduate dropped in eight three pointers. He is the second-leading 3-point shooter in school history with 286 career threes.

Hamilton paced four alumni in double figures. Nate Strong finished with 16 points. Kyle Stirmlinger added 15 points before fouling out. Joe Trottier chipped in 14 points, adding a pair of 3-pointers.

Any hopes Yellowjacket fans had of a big upset Tuesday night faded after about thirteen minutes as Brigham Young ran away from Montana State-Billings, 110-70.

"BYU played very hard and very intelligent," said Yellowjacket head coach Craig Carse. "Our kids battled hard. We just don't have the depth, the size or the experience. We're thankful to BYU for giving us this opportunity. We'll take a lot of good things from this game."

The Yellowjackets' Justin Hassell was the leading scorer in the game with 22 points. He was 8-of-15 from the field and 3-of-3 from beyond the arc. Hassell finished with a doubledouble, grabbing 11 rebounds.

Cameron Munoz scored 20 points, hitting 4-of-11 from 3point range. Buddy Windy Boy finished with 15 points, all on 3-pointers. He was 5-of-14 from long range. Freshmen Lucas Walker and Carlin Hughes added five points apiece. Munoz, Hughes and Jonathan Wiley each dished out four assists.

The Yellowjackets were 14-of-36 from 3-point range.

2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10th year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (1st year): After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

Brent Montague (8th year): After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
