This week's games may or may not be the final meetings between the Yellowjackets and Hawai-Hilo and Chaminade. However, it is the last time the teams will meet as Pacific West Conference foes. It was announced last Thursday that MSU-Billings will leave the PacWest for the Heartland Conference beginning next season. The conference change will eliminate the Yellowjackets' two annual trips to Hawaii and the Hawaii schools' one annual trip to Billings. The Jackets will make their final PacWest trip to the islands next week when they travel to face Hawaii Pacific and BYU-Hawaii.

This Week's Opponents:

<u>University of Hawaii at Hilo</u> – The Vulcans are ranked 16th nationally and first in the NCAA West Region with a 20-2 overall mark. They took over the lead in the PacWest standings last week with a two-game sweep of BYU-Hawaii. With only five games remaining, the Vulcans will likely earn their second berth to the NCAA Tournament in the last three years. If they are able to hold onto the No. 1 ranking in the region, they will host the West Region Tournament in Hilo.

The Vulcans are led by conference player of the year candidate Skip Esene. The 6-6 senior forward leads the PacWest and ranks 16th in the nation for scoring at 21.5 ppg. Guard Alex Cagagnot is averaging 14.2 points and 5.0 assists per game. Brian Graham adds 10.8 points a game.

<u>Chaminade University</u> – The Silverswords started the season strong at 10-4, but have won just three of their last seven. All four of their losses during that stretch were conference losses, including two to frontrunner Hawaii-Hilo.

Chaminade and MSU-Billings are in a battle for third place in the league. The two games in Billings this week will go a long way in determining where the teams will finish.

The Silverswords have three players who are capable of putting up big numbers. Chris Reaves is averaging 15.4 points a game. He scored 35 last Saturday in a win at Grand Canyon. Zack Whiting is one of the best guards in the conference, averaging 12.9 points, 6.0 rebounds and 7.1 assists per game. Corey Campbell is adding 11.0 points per game.

Last Week's Results:

The Yellowjackets were idle last week. They will be trying to extend their four-game PacWest winning streak this week.

Last Week's Highlights:

After averaging just over 109 points a game in the last two weeks, the Montana State-Billings men have moved up to No. 3 for scoring in the NCAA Division II basketball statistical rankings. The Yellowjackets (12-6) are averaging 92.9 points per game for the season. Pfeiffer leads the nation with a 98.6 ppg average.

The Yellowjackets are also fourth for 3-point field goals made per game (11.0) and eleventh for free throw percentage (76.2). MSU-Billings has made 63 3-pointers in its last five games, including 17 in a win over Western New Mexico last week. Oakland City leads the nation at 12.7 threes per game.

The Jackets' top two 3-point shooters rank in the top five nationally for individual 3-point shooting. Buddy Windy Boy is ranked fourth in Division II at 3.83 made 3-pointers per game. Cameron Munoz is close behind in fifth at 3.81 per game.

In other individual rankings this week, Windy Boy is sixteenth for 3-point field goal percentage. He has made 45.1 percent of his 152 attempts this season. Munoz is third in the nation for his 91.4 percent free throw percentage. Sophomore Jonathan Wiley ranks 25th for free throw percentage at 86.2.

2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10th year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (1st year): After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

Brent Montague (8th year): After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
