#### This Week's Opponents:

<u>Hawaii Pacific University</u> – The Sea Warriors are 8-12 overall and 2-8 in the PacWest. Their biggest win of the season came last week when they upset conference frontrunner BYU-Hawaii. HPU will have a chance to play PWC spoiler again next week when they face Hawaii-Hilo twice.

The Sea Warriors are led by guard Dante Sykes, who is averaging 14.9 points and 6.5 rebounds a game. He also leads the team for assists at 3.35 per game. Big man Audrius Peciukas is averaging 11.9 points and a team-high 8.4 rebounds a game. He is tied for the lead league with the Jackets' Justin Hassell with eight double-doubles.

Brigham Young University-Hawaii – After last week's loss at Hawaii Pacific, the Seasiders are fighting for their NCAA Tournament lives. Picked to win the PacWest and ranked as high as ninth nationally early in the season, BYUH is 12-7 overall and 7-3 in the conference. They likely need to win their remaining five PacWest games and get some help to catch UH-Hilo for the conference crown. UHH holds the tiebreaker with BYUH.

Reigning PacWest player of the year Jake Chrisman is averaging 18.9 points and 4.4 rebounds a game. Center Austin Smylie is adding 16.2 points and a team-leading 7.0 rebounds a game. Thomas Watkins has come on in the second half of the season and is scoring 13.2 ppg. He is second on the team with 34 three-pointers. Michael Stowell is averaging 13.7 points and 4.5 rebounds. His clutch 3-pointer forced overtime when the Seasiders won in Billings last month.

#### Last Week's Highlights:

Last week was bittersweet for the Yellowjackets. They pushed their conference winning streak to seven games with wins over UH-Hilo at Chaminade. The win over the 13<sup>th</sup>ranked Vulcans was by far MSUB's best performance of the season. However, early in Thursday's win over Chaminade, Lucas Walker went down with a broken hand, ending his season. The freshman from Australia was fast becoming a crowd favorite with his high flying dunks and instant offense.

Without Walker, the Jackets are back to familiar territory: making the second Hawaii trip with a short bench. Last year they played the final game in Hawaii with just five players. This week MSU-Billings will travel with only eight players. Sophomore Kerington Youmans will miss the trip because of a team rule violation.

In Saturday's win against Chaminade, Cameron Munoz scored a game-high 31 points with seven 3-pointers. Justin Hassell finished with 25 points and six rebounds. He was 6of-10 from the field and 12-of-15 from the free throw line. Buddy Windy Boy added 14 points and four 3-pointers. Drew Arnold came off the bench to score six points and grab six rebounds in 14 minutes of action. The six rebounds were a season high for the freshman. Carlin Hughes added seven points to go with a career-high nine assists.

Munoz led all players with 23 points in Thursday's win, hitting 4-of-16 from beyond the arc and 5-of-6 from the line. Hassell finished with his league-leading eighth doubledouble of the season, scoring 16 points and grabbing a career-high 18 rebounds. Hughes added 12 points and four assists. He was 4-of-4 from the line in the final two minutes of the game. Jonathan Wiley scored seven points and dished out a game-high five assists. He also blocked three shots, including a 3-point attempt by Dylan McCune that could have tied the game with 31 seconds left.

In the upset win over the Vulcans, Hughes finished with a career-high 27 points, hitting 13-of-17 from the stripe and 4of-8 from 3-point range. He also handed out a game-high six assists. Munoz shared high scoring honors with Hughes, dropping in 27 points and seven 3-pointers. The Jackets were 16-of-37 from beyond the arc in the game. Windy Boy finished with 17 points on 6-of-11 shooting. Hassell notched a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

# 2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10<sup>th</sup> year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

**Dave Carse (1st year):** After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

**Brent Montague (8<sup>th</sup> year):** After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
