This Week's Opponents:

Montana State University-Northern – The Lights are 12-15 overall after a six game losing skid. Northern lost to Westminster and Lewis-Clark State last week. The Lights' last win was January 29 against Great Falls. Despite the losing record, MSUN is averaging four points a game more than its opponents. The Lights are allowing just 66.6 points a game.

Guard Jordan Matthews leads the team in scoring at 13.0 ppg. He has made a team-high 48 three-pointers. Marcus Wilson is averaging 10.8 points and a team-high 6.3 rebounds a game.

Johnson & Wales University – The Wildcats are an even 14-14 on the season after back-to-back wins. They have had a season of streaks, with a six-game midseason winning streak and two five game losing streaks. J&W's last game was a 124-118 shootout win at Midland Lutheran College on Saturday.

Donald Whitfield leads the team in scoring at 22.2 points per game. He has 84 three-pointers and is shooting 44 percent from behind the arc. Mike Gomez is averaging 17.7 points and a team-best 6.2 rebounds a game. Ryan Moats is adding 13.2 points with 74 threes. Will Butler averages 11.8 points and 6.0 rebounds.

Montana State-Billings suffered its second-straight 30 point loss Saturday, falling at BYU-Hawaii 118-84. The loss dropped the Jackets to 16-8 overall and 8-6 in the PacWest, while the Seasideers improved to 15-7, 10-3.

The Seasideers blew open the game early in the second half, building their lead to as many as 44. MSU-Billings hit 13 second half 3-pointers, but couldn't stop BYU-Hawaii defensively. The Seasideers shot 70 percent from the field in the second stanza and 69 percent for the game.

Justin Hassell led the Jackets with 23 points and eight rebounds. He was 9-of-21 from the field and 3-of-5 from 3-point range. Cameron Munoz finished with 19 points and seven assists. Buddy Windy Boy and Cody Samuelson each scored 15 points. Windy Boy hit five 3-pointers. Samuelson's 15 points were a career high, as were his three 3-pointers.

Carlin Hughes scored nine points and dished out eight assists. Hassell, Hughes, Munoz, and Samuelson each had three 3-pointers. Jay Jamieson made one and scored three points.

The Jackets had their eight game conference winning streak snapped Thursday night as the Yellowjackets fell at BYU-Hawaii, 115-84. MSU-Billings lost for the first time since January 18 when BYU-Hawaii won a 100-99 overtime decision in Billings.

The Seaside pulled away in the second half with a 20-2 run between 18:17 and 13:34. That run took the wind out of the Jackets' sails and stalled the offense. BYU-Hawaii built an 88-61 lead by the 10 minute mark and coasted to the win, leading by as many as 37.

Justin Hassell led the Yellowjackets with 23 points on 9-of-18 shooting from the field. Cameron Munoz finished with 21 points, hitting 5-of-14 from 3-point range. The Yellowjackets were 14-of-40 from beyond the arc.

Carlin Hughes added 16 points and a career-high 11 assists. He was 4-of-11 from 3-point range. Buddy Windy Boy netted 15 points with three 3-pointers. Munoz, Hughes, and Windy Boy each played all 40 minutes. Hassell logged 38 minutes. Cody Samuelson had five points and a team-high nine rebounds before fouling out. Drew Arnold came off the bench to score four points in 15 minutes.

After missing two straight free throws in the final minutes, Cameron Munoz bounced back to drain a game-winning 3-pointer with 2.6 seconds on the clock Tuesday, giving Montana State-Billings a 92-90 win at Hawaii Pacific.

After the slow start, the Yellowjackets found their offensive rhythm to take a 46-41 halftime lead after leading by as many as seven. The Sea Warriors quickly erased the Jackets' lead after halftime and led for much of the second half. The see-saw second half saw neither team lead by more than eight points. After MSU-Billings came back from an eight point deficit, Munoz had a chance to extend MSUB's 87-85 lead with two free throws with 2:12 to play. He missed both, allowing HPU to tie the game at 87-87 on the next possession.

After the team's traded baskets, HPU's Audrius Peciukas was sent to the line with 15 seconds remaining and hit one of the two free throws to give the Sea Warriors a 90-89 lead. Following a timeout, the Yellowjackets were able to spring Munoz on the wing for the game winner. The Sea Warriors were not able to get a shot off in the final seconds.

All five MSU-Billings starters scored in double figures, led by Munoz's 24 points. He was 5-of-10 from 3-point range. Justin Hassell and Windy Boy finished with 20 points each. Hassell had 14 points for his league-leading ninth double-double.

Carlin Hughes and Cody Samuelson each scored 14 points. Hughes was 4-of-10 from behind the arc and finished with a career-high nine assists. The Jackets' only players off the bench were true freshmen Drew Arnold and Jay Jamieson. The pair combined for eight minutes.

2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10th year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (1st year): After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

Brent Montague (8th year): After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
