This Week's Opponent:

Northwest Nazarene University Crusaders – The Crusaders were picked to finish eighth in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference and are off to a 3-5 overall start. One of those losses was to the Yellowjackets last Wednesday. NNU defeated Cal State-Bakersfield, 82-67, on Saturday.

The Crusaders have two players averaging double figures and are scoring 77.2 points a game as a team. Mesut Ademoglu leads the team and ranks seventh in the GNAC at 15.1 ppg. The 6-foot-10 forward from Istanbul is shooting 53 percent from the field. He also leads the team in rebounding at 8.2 per game.

Raymond Butler is averaging 12.9 points after coming off the bench in seven of the team's eight games. Ryan McCarthy is third on the team at 9.8 ppg and leads the team with 16 3-pointers.

Last Week's Highlights:

Cody Samuelson put back his own miss with three seconds remaining to lift the Montana State-Billings men's basketball team to a 66-64 win at Northwest Nazarene on Wednesday. The Yellowjackets remained unbeaten on the season, improving to 5-0.

Following a Jonathan Wiley steal with 23 seconds remaining, the Yellowjackets worked the ball around to Samuelson on the baseline. His baseline jumper fell short, but he came up with the rebound and the put back to give MSU-Billings a two-point lead. The Crusaders missed a 3-point attempt as time expired.

The Yellowjackets jumped out to a quick start, taking a 24-13 lead at the 10:38 mark of the first half. A swarming defense led to quick points off turnovers for MSU-Billings as eight Yellowjacket steals led to 14 Crusader turnovers in the first half.

MSU-Billings let a 12-point halftime lead evaporate as the Crusaders put the defensive clamps on the Yellowjackets' perimeter shooters. MSU-Billings shot 51 percent from the field and 40 from 3-point range in the first half. Cameron Munoz (Jr., Chino, CA) scored 16 first half points to lead the Yellowjackets to a 44-32 halftime lead.

Munoz knocked down all four of the Jackets' first half 3-pointers, but did not score after halftime. Buddy Windy Boy picked up the slack from behind the arc with both of his 3-pointers coming in the second half. Windy Boy fouled out of the game with more than six minutes remaining. The Yellowjackets shot just 30 percent from the field and 18 percent from 3-point range in the second half.

MSU-Billings went cold offensively in the second half, and NNU climbed back into the game. The Crusaders cut the Jackets' lead to just four by the midpoint of the half and eventually tied the game with just under six minutes to play. Joseph Wade's basket gave the Crusaders a 61-59 lead with 4:44 remaining. It was NNU's second lead of the game and first since the score was 5-4.

MSU-Billings tied the game on the following possession with a Justin Hassell jumper. Hassell scored a game-high 22 points on 10-of-17 shooting from the field, although he was just 2-of-8 from the free throw line.

The teams traded a free throw apiece over the final minute and a half before Raymond Butler's jumper for the Crusaders tied the game at 64. A Hassell turnover with 30 seconds to play gave Northwest Nazarene a chance to win the game, but Wiley's steal led to Samuelson's game-winner.

Hassell and Munoz were the only Yellowjackets in double figures as the team finished with a season low for points. MSU-Billings entered the game averaging over 100 points a game. Windy Boy and Lucas Walker finished with eight points apiece. Three Jackets scored four points, including Samuelson and Wiley.

"The guys played hard and found a way to win," said Yellowjacket head coach Craig Carse of his team's first road game of the year. "We played great team defense. Offensively Cameron got a little flat, but played a gutsy second half. Justin missed some free throws, but he played a great game and played his heart out. It was a win."

NNU was led by 15 points apiece from Mesut Ademoglu and Butler. Wade finished with 11 points. Daniel Nyom led all players with 11 rebounds to go with seven points.

2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10th year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (1st year): After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

Brent Montague (8th year): After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
