This Week's Opponent:

<u>Brigham Young University</u> – The Cougars are in a rebuilding year after going 21-9 last year and advancing to the NCAA Tournament. BYU is currently 5-10 after losing five of its last eight games.

The Cougars will be looking to snap a two-game losing streak against the Jackets on Tuesday. They lost to a good St. Mary's team by 21 on Tuesday before dropping a heartbreaker to San Diego State on Saturday. BYU was outscored 6-0 in the final 49 seconds of the 59-57 loss. The loss to San Diego State snapped a 12-game Mountain West Conference winning streak at the Marriott Center.

The Cougars are led by Mike Hall, a 6-3 guard who is averaging 13.7 points a game. He is shooting 42 percent from the field and 38 percent from 3-point range. He is fourth on the team for rebounds at 4.0 per game and is the only player to start all 15 games this season.

Three players are averaging nine points a game for BYU. Jared Jensen, a 6-9 forward, is averaging 9.5 points and 3.8 rebounds. Guards Mike Rose and Austin Ainge are also averaging nine points a game. Ainge is the son of former Cougars star Danny Ainge, the 1981 NCAA Player of the Year who went on to win two NBA championships with the Boston Celtics.

The Cougars have been going deep into their bench so far this season. Ten players are averaging over 11 minutes a game and Hall is the only one logging more than 30 minutes a night.

Three players are averaging just over five rebounds a game for the Cougars. Keena Young, a 6-6 forward, is the leading rebounder at 5.7 a game.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets ended their three-game trip to Hawaii with a 106-85 loss at Hawaii-Hilo. The Yellowjackets dropped all three of their PacWest Conference games in Hawaii, falling to 8-4 overall and 0-3 in the PacWest.

Justin Hassell led the Yellowjackets with 19 points before fouling out with more than 10 minutes to play. Carlin Hughes added 17 points and was 5-of-10 from behind the arc. Buddy Windy Boy finished with 11 points and a teamhigh four assists.

Cody Samuelson came off the bench to net nine points for MSU-Billings. Jonathan Wiley added eight points. Freshman Drew Arnold led the team with five rebounds and had six points. MSU-Billings was out rebounded 40-23.

After trailing by 20 points, Montana State-Billings rallied but fell short at Hawaii-Hilo Thursday night, losing 76-61. The Yellowjackets were led by Buddy Windy Boy's 19 points. He was 7-of-14 from the field and 3-of-8 from 3-point range. The Jackets shot just 16 percent from behind the arc in the game—making 4-of-25—and only 30 percent from the field.

Justin Hassell finished with 17 points on 5-of-16 shooting from the field and 7-of-9 from the free throw line. He notched a double-double with 11 rebounds. Freshman Lucas Walker added 10 points off the bench.

Despite a fast start, Montana State-Billings dropped its PacWest Conference opener at Chaminade on Tuesday, 90-58. Lucas Walker finished the night with 19 points on 6-of-14 shooting from the field. He was a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. Freshman Drew Arnold scored a seasonhigh 10 points, hitting 4-of-6 from the line and 3-of-7 from the field. No other Yellowjacket scored in double figures and MSU-Billings made just four 3-pointers as a team. Justin Hassell and Jonathan Wiley led the Jackets with six rebounds apiece.

2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10th year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (1st year): After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

Brent Montague (8th year): After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
