Nov. 26 – vs. Minot State, 2 p.m., Alterowitz Gym

This Week's Opponent:

Minot State University – The Beavers started the season 0-3 with losses to Regina, Montana State-Northern, and Brandon. They bounced back to even their record at 3-3 with home wins against MSU-Northern, Rocky Mountain, and Great Falls. The Beavers will host Montana-Western on Wednesday before they travel to Billings for a Saturday afternoon game against the Yellowjackets.

Minot returns NAIA All-American Courtney Haley who averaged 14 ppg last year. Four other returning players averaged 10 ppg last year. Minot won 23 games a year ago, qualifying for the NAIA national tournament.

Haley has been the Beavers' most consistent scorer again this season. The 6'2" guard is averaging 16 points a game through the first six games and has scored in double figures all six times. No other Minot player has scored over 10 points in all six games. In Sunday's win over Great Falls, Charles Rourk dropped in 18 points on 4-of-6 shooting from 3-point range.

Last Week's Results:

MSU-Billings 120, Johnson & Wales 67

Last Week's Highlights:

If Monday's men's basketball game had been a fight, it would have ended in a first round TKO. Montana State-Billings scored early and often to blitz Johnson & Wales 120-67 in the Yellowjackets' regular season opener.

The Yellowjackets knocked down 17 3-pointers in the game, led by 11 from senior captain Cameron Munoz (Chino, CA). Munoz matched his career high with 39 points and connected on 11-of-19 from behind the arc.

With the 11 triples in the season opener, Munoz jump started his chase for the school 3-point record. He now has 315 career 3-pointers, leaving him within 56 of Markus Hallgrimson's 371. Monday's game marked the third time in his career that Munoz has made at least 10 3-pointers in a game.

The Wildcats never threatened. MSU-Billings opened the game with an 11-0 run with a pair of Munoz 3-pointers, a Lucas Walker (So., Launceston, Australia) dunk, and three free throws from Buddy Windy Boy (Sr., Lodge Grass, MT). Johnson & Wales finally broke into the scoring column with a Jeremy Jones layup at 16:49 to get within 11-2, but that was the last time the Wildcats trailed by fewer than 10 points.

MSU-Billings led by as many as 21 in the first half before cooling off and settling for a 48-33 halftime advantage. It took just the first five minutes of the second half to double that lead. A Windy Boy 3-pointer gave the Yellowjackets a 67-37 lead with 15 minutes to play. The Wildcats weren't able to get within 30 for the rest of the night.

Along with Munoz's 39, four other Yellowjackets scored in double figures. Walker battled foul trouble to finish with a double-double of 13 points and 12 rebounds. Senior Moritz Wohlers (Wolfenbuttel, Germany) also doubled up with a dozen points and 11 boards.

Windy Boy finished with 14 points and two blocked shots. Sophomore Drew Arnold (Tempe, AZ) recorded a career-high 11 points in just 13 minutes of action off the bench. He also grabbed eight rebounds and blocked a shot. The Yellowjackets had five blocked shots as a team.

Jonathan Wiley (Jr., Westlake Village, CA) and Cody Samuelson (Jr., Broadus, MT) added eight points and four rebounds apiece off the bench. Point guard Carlin Hughes (So., Perth, Australia) narrowly missed a double-double with nine points and 12 assists. Freshman Carl Johnson (Rapid City, SD) netted six points on 3-of-3 shooting in his first collegiate game. Redshirt freshman Brett Weese (Wilkie, Saskatchewan) also made his collegiate debut, handing out three assists.

Craig Carse (11th year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Carse is second all-time at MSU-Billings for career victories. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (2nd year): Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
