This Week's Opponent:

Emporia State University – The Hornets are ranked 20th in the most recent NABC national poll. Ranked as high as 16th earlier this season, they are 7-3 overall, including a 5-0 mark at home. Monday's game will be the first South Central Region game for the Yellowjackets since moving to the Heartland Conference. MSUB will make a return trip to Emporia, KS, on January 22.

Emporia opened the season at a tournament hosted by BYU-Hawaii, going 2-1 in the islands against three teams Yellowjacket fans are familiar with. The Hornets lost the opener to Western Washington before beating BYU-Hawaii and Hawaii Pacific. The Hornets last game was a 73-60 conference loss to Missouri Southern. They will host Northeastern State on Saturday before flying to Billings on Sunday.

The Hornets have won with defense, holding opponents to just 67.9 ppg. Monday's game will be a clash of styles as the Yellowjackets will enter the game averaging 108.2 ppg. Shawn Herman and Tyrell Sledge lead the Hornets in scoring at 13.6 ppg each. Wes Book is adding 12.9 ppg.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets swept cross-town rival Rocky Mountain College in an entertaining weekend series. Thursday saw Rocky overcome a double-digit deficit in the second half to take a brief lead late in the game. The Yellowjackets responded with timely 3-point shooting down the stretch to pull away for a 10-point win.

On Saturday, the Yellowjackets had early foul trouble that sent the Bears to the free throw line 22 times in the first half. MSU-Billings broke away from a 43-43 halftime tie with 57 second-half points to blowout the Bears on their home floor.

Senior guard Cameron Munoz was named the Heartland Conference player of the week for his two-game performance. He averaged 31.5 ppg against the Bears, knocking down 13-of-27 from 3-point range. He scored a game-high 36 points on Saturday.

Sophomore point guard Carlin Hughes also had a big week, averaging 20 points and 12 assists per game. He posted a double-double on Thursday with 15 points and 15 assists. He netted a season-high 25 points on Saturday with 20 second-half points.

Moritz Wohlers averaged 13.5 points and 9.0 rebounds against the Bears. Lucas Walker added 17.5 ppg, including 23 points on Saturday.

While the Yellowjacket offense was in high gear, the Yellowjacket defense played a role in creating scoring opportunities. MSUB had 27 steals in the two games, boosting the Jackets' season average to 12.3 steals per game. In their first four games the Yellowjackets have only had one game with fewer than 10 steals, and that was a nine-steal day against Minot State.

2005-2006 Yellowjackets Coaches



Craig Carse (11th year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. In the last 10 years the Jackets are 142-10 at Alterowitz Gym and have averaged 103.3 ppg at home. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last 10 seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.8 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Carse is second all-time at MSU-Billings for career victories. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1987, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (2nd year): Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
