This Week's Events:

This Week's Opponents:

East Central University (OK) – The Tigers are 5-3 overall and 4-1 in their last four games. Their only loss during that stretch was to the Yellowjackets' opponent on Friday, Texas A&M-Kingsville. East Central is averaging 74 ppg while holding its opponents to just 67.2 ppg. The Tigers have already blocked 39 shots on the season with two players over 10. About a quarter of their field goals come from 3-point range and they are out-rebounding their opponents by an average of 10 per game.

Four of the Tigers' five starters have started all eight games this year and three of them average double figures for scoring. Jason Thomas, a 6-2 junior guard, leads the team in scoring at 15.5 ppg. He also has 10 blocked shots and is shooting 83 percent from the free throw line. Terrell Carpenter and Chris Bingle are adding 12.5 and 11.1 ppg respectively. Bingle, a 6-10 forward, leads the team in rebounding at 5.4 rpg.

Thursday's game will be the first meeting between the Yellowjackets and Tigers.

Texas A&M Kingsville – The Javelinas are 6-3 overall and have recorded three wins against teams from the Heartland Conference. After starting the season 4-0, TAMUK is just 2-3 since December 3. The Javelinas' defense has been solid, holding opponents to just 66.7 ppg. In three of their six wins they have held opponents below 60 points.

Remi Yusuf, a 6-4 junior guard, might be the most dangerous scorer the Yellowjackets have faced this season. He is averaging 18.7 ppg and has led the Javelinas in scoring in all but two of their nine games. He's scored at least 20 points four times and gets to the free throw line over five times a game. Yusuf also leads the team in rebounding at 7.5 rpg. Bobby Pandy is adding 13 ppg. Ricky Huckaby and Kia Griffin each add over 10 ppg.

Last Week's Results:

MSU-Billings 118, Emporia State 110

Last Week's Highlights:

Yellowjacket fans were given an early Christmas treat last Monday night when the Jackets pulled out a thrilling 118-110 win over visiting Emporia State. The Yellowjackets and Hornets combined for 31 3-pointers and the 228 combined points were the fourth-most in Yellowjacket history.

Emporia State, ranked in the national top 20 for most of the season, entered the game with an 8-3 overall record. The Hornets represented the Yellowjackets' first-ever South Central Region contest since MSU-Billings joined the Heartland Conference.

Along with an incredible tempo, the game featured several impressive individual performances. Two Hornets scored over 20 points and one netted over 30. The Yellowjackets matched with five double-figure scorers, including a pair of seniors that went for 30. Center Moritz Wohlers scored a career-high 33 and grabbed 14 rebounds. Guard Cameron Munoz dropped in 30—his third 30-point performance in five games—and made six 3-pointers.

"Mighty Mo" was 8-of-13 from the field and 17-of-20 from the free throw line as the Hornets had no answer for stopping him in the paint. The 17 made free throws rank fourth in school history for a game. Munoz continued his sharp shooting from all over the floor, knocking down 10-of-16 from the field and 6-of-10 from behind the arc. He raised his conference-leading scoring average to 28 ppg.

Starters Carlin Hughes and Buddy Windy Boy scored 19 and 16 points respectively and combined for seven 3-pointers. Cody Samuelson came off the bench to score a career-high 18 points on 7-of-11 shooting from the field, including several key buckets down the stretch.

As a team the Yellowjackets had their best shooting night of the season against the Hornets. They hit 54.7 percent of their shots from the field, including 53.6 percent from long range. They also shot 84.6 percent from the charity stripe, a place they had struggled through the first four games.

Craig Carse (11th year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. In the last 10 years the Jackets are 142-10 at Alterowitz Gym and have averaged 103.3 ppg at home. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last 10 seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.8 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Carse is second all-time at MSU-Billings for career victories. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1987, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (2nd year): Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
