This Week's Opponent:

St. Edward's University – Ranked sixth in the most recent NCAA South Central Region poll (the next poll will be released on Wednesday, 2/8/06), the Hilltoppers have dropped two straight including a 136-101 shootout in Billings less than two weeks ago. St. Ed's lost to Texas-Pan American in a low scoring affair last week, 62-44. The Hilltoppers will host Lincoln University on Wednesday before the Yellowjackets visit Austin on Friday and Saturday. The remaining conference schedule works in favor of the Hilltoppers, who will play four of their final six conference games at home.

A St. Ed's win against Lincoln on Wednesday will set up another battle for first place between the Hilltoppers and Yellowjackets. When the teams met on January 28, both were 5-0 in the conference going into the game. MSU-Billings is now 7-0 and St. Ed's would be 6-1 with a win over Lincoln. Although both teams will still have four conference games remaining after the weekend series, the games in Austin on Friday and Saturday could play a major role in determining home court advantage for the conference playoffs that will be held March 1 and 4.

St. Edward's will enter the week averaging 77.8 points per game while giving up just 73.1. Three different players average double figures led by David Lunn's 15.5 ppg. Lunn scored a team-high 20 points in the loss in Billings. Shawn Weinstein adds 13.8 ppg, and Daniel Pierre averages 12.5 ppg and a team-high 8.4 rebounds a game.

Last Week's Highlights Continued:

half seasons at MSU-Billings and 283-134 all time as a collegiate head coach. Mike Harkins holds the school record for career wins with 280 when the Yellowjackets were members of the NAIA. Carse's 200 wins are the most at the school since it moved to NCAA Division II.

The Yellowjackets routed Lincoln, 128-82, on Friday behind a season-high 20 three-pointers. Five different Yellowjackets had at least three 3-pointers led by Buddy Windy Boy's six. He was 6-of-8 from behind the arc, scoring 18 points. Windy Boy also had four steals to move up to fifth in school history with 112 career steals. Seven different players scored in double figures, including all five starters as the Jackets recorded their second-highest point total of the year. Jonathan Wiley had his best game of the season with a career-high 27 points. He made 3-of-3 from 3-point range and 16-of-18 from the free throw line.

Carse's 200th win on Saturday came a little tougher than No. 199 on Saturday. The Blue Tigers hung around for about 25 minutes before the Jackets' inside-outside game kicked in. All five starters scored in double figures. Point guard Carlin Hughes recorded his fifth-straight double-double with 17 points and 15 assists. Cameron Munoz scored a game-high 31 points and hit eight 3-pointers, opening the way for Moritz Wohlers to score 20 points in the paint. With his fourth 3-pointer of the game Munoz became the sixth player in NCAA Division II history to make 400 career 3-pointers. With eight regular season games remaining—and potentially conference playoff games—Munoz needs 39 threes to tie the all-time DII record of 443.

Craig Carse (11th year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. In the last 10 years the Jackets are 142-10 at Alterowitz Gym and have averaged 103.3 ppg at home. Carse entered the 2005-2006 season with a career 185-89 record at MSU-Billings, ranking second in school history for career victories. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last 10 seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.8 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1987, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (2nd year): Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
