### This Week's Opponents:

<u>Johnson & Wales University</u> – The Wildcats, an NAIA team from Denver, are making their second trip to Billings in less than a year. They lost a 124-92 shootout to the Yellowjackets last season on Senior Day at Alterowitz Gym, and they will open the Yellowjackets' home schedule this season with a rare Monday night game.

The Wildcats were an explosive offensive team last year, averaging 90 points a game. The start to the 2005-2006 campaign has been a different story after the loss of three of their top four scorers. J&W will be 0-3 when it comes to Billings on Monday, and the Wildcats have been blown out in all three games. They opened the season with a 95-69 loss at Kansas Wesleyan. Over the weekend they lost 91-63 to Minnesota State-Moorhead and 99-68 to South Dakota Tech.

No season statistics are available for the Wildcats. Guards Tim Wright, Eric Daniels and Danny Lopez have each scored in double figures in the last two games. Senior forward Mike Gomez is the Wildcats' top returning scorer, but has yet to play this season. He averaged 18.7 ppg last year and netted 26 in the loss at MSU-Billings.

<u>Minot State University</u> – The Beavers started the season 0-3 with losses to Regina, Montana State-Northern, and Brandon. They bounced back with home wins against MSU-Northern and Rocky Mountain College. Minot hosts University of Great Falls on Sunday.

Complete season statistics are not available for the Beavers, an NAIA team from Minot, ND. They return NAIA All-American Courtney Haley who averaged 14 ppg last year. Four other returning players averaged 10 ppg last year. Minot won 23 games a year ago, qualifying for the NAIA national tournament.

# Last Week's Results:

The Yellowjackets did not play last week. Monday's game against Johnson & Wales will be their regular season opener.

# Notes:

The Yellowjackets' new league, the Heartland Conference, did not fare too well during the opening week of the 2005-2006 season. Heartland teams were a combined 1-7 against non-conference competition. The lone victory came from St. Edward's University, who defeated Norwich 89-57 on Friday. Oklahoma Panhandle was 0-2, Lincoln was 0-1, St. Mary's was 0-1, Western New Mexico was 0-2, and St. Edward's was 1-1.

The Yellowjackets and Incarnate Word are the only two Heartland teams yet to play. Both will open the regular season on Monday. All seven conference teams will play at least once this week.

While the Yellowjackets' focus this year will be on winning the Heartland Conference Championship, Yellowjacket fans will be closely watching the climb through the school record books of senior guards Cameron Munoz and Buddy Windy Boy. Munoz begins the season needing 67 3-pointers to tie Markus Hallgrimson's school record of 371. Munoz hasn't had a season with fewer than 96 threes in his three seasons as a Yellowjacket. Windy Boy, meanwhile, has a good chance of finishing in the top three for career 3-pointers. He starts the year 70 behind Mark Hamilton.

Both Munoz and Windy Boy will also finish their careers in the top 20 in school history for scoring. Munoz starts 2005-2006 at ninth with 1,268 points. The school record of 1,883 points is held by Roy McPipe. Windy Boy will start his senior campaign with 931 points. He will become the  $21^{st}$  player in school history to score over 1,000 points.

# 2005-2006 Yellowjackets Coaches



Craig Carse (11<sup>th</sup> year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Carse is second all-time at MSU-Billings for career victories. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (2<sup>nd</sup> vear): Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowiackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
