MSU-Billings 120, Johnson & Wales 67 MSU-Billings 111, Minot State 79

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets rolled through the opening week of the season with two easy wins over a pair of NAIA teams. MSU-Billings ran up 231 total points in dispatching Johnson & Wales and Minot State.

The Jackets' two senior captains carried the week. Cameron Munoz dropped in a career-high 39 points while knocking down 11 3-pointers in Monday's win over Johnson & Wales. Buddy Windy Boy scored a career-high 33 points with nine 3-pointers in Saturday's victory against Minot State. For the week the pair combined for 94 points and 23 3-pointers.

Munoz inched closer to the school record for 3-pointers with his 315th last week. His magic number for catching Markus Hallgrimson is now 56. He also went over 1,300 career points.

Windy Boy made gains in his climb through the school record books for both 3-pointers and points. He moved up to fifth all-time with 228 career 3-pointers, passing Danny Phillips. Windy Boy is now within three 3-pointers of Reece Gliko's 231 for fourth all-time in school history. He also climbed to 21^{st} for career points with 978. It's likely that during next week's two-game series with Rocky, Windy Boy will become the 21^{st} player in school history to score 1,000 points. With 38 more points he'll move up to 20^{th} on the all-time scoring list.

Three newcomers made their Yellowjacket debuts last week. Senior transfer Moritz Wohlers had a solid week averaging 14 points and nine rebounds a game. He posted a double-double of 12 points and 11 boards against J&W. Freshman Carl Johnson averaged five points and 2.5 rebounds in just eight minutes a game. Redshirt freshman Brett Weese played six minutes each night and had four assists.

Windy Boy was named the Heartland Conference player of the week for his performance in the Jackets' season-opening victories. He became the Yellowjackets' first player of the week award winner since MSU-Billings joined the Heartland Conference.

2005-2006 Yellowjackets Coaches



Craig Carse (11th year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Carse is second all-time at MSU-Billings for career victories. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (2nd year): Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
