# This Week's Opponent:

<u>Rocky Mountain College</u> – The Battlin' Bears have played nine more games than have the Yellowjackets so far this season and will bring a 6-5 record to Alterowitz Gym. Three of their six wins have been against teams from Canada.

Rocky started the season 4-1 before a four-game losing skid in November. Last weekend at a tournament in Havre, the Bears defeated Concordia University of Calgary, 111-76, and King's University College of Alberta, 104-60.

Through 11 games Rocky is averaging 86 points per game while giving up just 76.7. The Bears have averaged 92.8 ppg in their wins and 77.8 ppg in their losses. David Ellis is averaging 15.6 ppg and 5.5 rpg. Devin Uskoski averages 12.8 ppg, and Chris Nickolai addes 11.1 ppg.

MSU-Billings 132, Alumni Team 94

#### Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets stayed sharp during their off week with a 132-94 win over the MSU-Billings Alumni on Saturday night at Alterowitz Gymnasium. The Yellowjackets, currently 2-0, will return to regular season play when they host cross town rival Rocky Mountain College on December 8. Tip off is set for 7 p.m.

Yellowjacket Cameron Munoz and the Alumni's Willy Davison made seven 3-pointers and 29 points apiece to lead all players. Sophomore Jay Jamieson knocked down eight 3-pointers and 24 points. The Yellowjackets made 27 3-pointers as a team with five Yellowjackets finishing in double figures for scoring. Moritz Wohlers went 7-for-11 from the line and netted 16 points.

The Alumni team, led by Willy Davison, also had five players scoring in double figures. Nate Strong put down 19 points before fouling out. Teammates Mark Hamilton and Joe Trottier scored 15 and 14 points respectively.

# 2005-2006 Yellowjackets Coaches



Craig Carse (11<sup>th</sup> year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. In the last 10 years the Jackets are 142-10 at Alterowitz Gym and have averaged 103.3 ppg at home. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last 10 seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.8 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Carse is second all-time at MSU-Billings for career victories. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1987, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division II, Division II and NAIA levels.

**Dave Carse (2<sup>nd</sup> year):** Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
