### This Week's Opponent:

**Lincoln University** – The Blue Tigers will bring a 7-13 overall record and a 2-4 league mark to Alterowitz Gym on Friday after busing from Jefferson City, MO. At one point in the conference season the Tigers were 2-2, but two-straight losses have dropped them into a tie for fifth in the Heartland Conference.

Through the first 17 games of the season Titus Byrd led the Blue Tigers in just about every offensive category. However, because of eligibility issues he has not played since January 14 when he scored 26 in a road win at Incarnate Word. Byrd, who averages 21.2 ppg, is not expected to play in Billings.

The Yellowjackets fought off foul trouble just two weeks ago to come away with a 93-66 win against Lincoln in Jefferson City. Four different Yellowjackets finished the game with four fouls, but none fouled out. Moritz Wohlers and Cameron Munoz each scored 23 for the Yellowjackets in that game. The Blue Tigers' Brandon Jones came off the bench to score 16 points, and Darrin Laye added a dozen. Not counting Byrd, no Blue Tigers average double figures for the season. Taeshaud Jackson averages 9.0 ppg and 6.0 rpg, and Luther Glover adds 8.5 ppg.

**Last Week's Highlights Continued:**

The Yellowjackets made three lay-ups and three 3-pointers in the first four and a half minutes of the game to jump to a 21-4 lead. In the first eight minutes of the game the Jackets were 12-of-14 from the field and led 36-13.

MSU-Billings delivered the TKO punch by halftime with one of the best offensive halves a basketball team could put together. By intermission the Yellowjackets had scored 78 points, made 23 of 32 field goals (71.9%), and made nine of 15 three pointers (60%). That's an entire game for many teams. In fact, the Yellowjackets' 78 first half points matched or bettered what the Hilltoppers had allowed in 15 of their previous 18 games.

Carlin Hughes had a career game, scoring 45 points and dishing out 10 assists for his eighth double-double of the year. He was named the Heartland Conference player of the week. Hughes became just the tenth player in school history to score at least 45 points in a game.

Six Yellowjackets scored in double figures. Moritz Wohlers netted an efficient 25 points on 8-of-9 shooting from the field and 8-of-11 from the line. Lucas Walker scored 21, hitting 7-of-11 from the field. Cameron Munoz added 19 points, making three 3-pointers and 8-of-9 at the free throw line. Buddy Windy Boy had a dozen points and Jonathan Wiley finished with 11.

By the end the Yellowjackets had scored the fourth-most points in school history, shooting 59 percent from the field. And the final result of pressing the Jackets: 29 points off turnovers for MSU-Billings to 11 for St. Edwards, and 28 fast break points for the Jackets to six for the Hilltoppers.

### 2005-2006 Yellowjackets Coaches



**Craig Carse (11<sup>th</sup> year):** Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. In the last 10 years the Jackets are 142-10 at Alterowitz Gym and have averaged 103.3 ppg at home. Carse entered the 2005-2006 season with a career 185-89 record at MSU-Billings, ranking second in school history for career victories. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last 10 seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.8 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1987, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II, Division II and NAIA levels.

**Dave Carse (2<sup>nd</sup> year):** Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
