This Week's Opponents:

Oklahoma Panhandle State University – The Aggies are about the hottest team in the Heartland Conference right now. They started the season by losing 14 of their first 15 games. Since then they are 7-3. The Aggies will enter the week at 5-5 in the Heartland Conference and fighting for one of the league's four playoff spots. They haven't lost a conference game at home this year. The Aggies lost twice to the Yellowjackets in Billings at the beginning of January, but both games were close.

Four different players average double figures for OPSU, led by Aaron Harrison's 15.9 ppg. Harrison also leads the Aggies in rebounding at 8.9 rpg. Eddie Moss and Nick Malinowski each average over 13 ppg, and William Preston adds 10.4 points.

Western New Mexico University – The Mustangs are also fighting for one of the conference playoff spots. They are just 5-19 overall, but all five wins have been conference games and they enter the week at 5-5 in the league. The Mustangs will host Lincoln on Wednesday before the Yellowjackets play in Silver City on Friday and Saturday.

Senior guard Matt Enriquez leads the Mustangs in scoring at 15.8 ppg. Mike Sells and Trey Clarkson also average double figures. Enriquez, Sells and Clarkson have each made over 40 3-pointers this season and have combined for 136 of the team's 215 threes. Enriquez, one of the Mustangs' top shooters and scorers for several years, is shooting over 40 percent from behind the arc.

Last Week's Highlights:

The Yellowjackets had three important games at home last week and came away with three wins and one big loss. The Jackets knocked off Incarnate Word on Wednesday and St. Mary's on Friday and Saturday. Early in Saturday's non-conference win against the Rattlers, Yellowjacket forward Lucas Walker was intentionally taken out by a Rattlers player on a breakaway dunk attempt. The injuries sustained in the fall ended Walker's season.

The Yellowjackets fought cold shooting and a determined UIW squad to win by five on Wednesday. MSUB was just 7-of-26 from 3-point range, but held the Cardinals to just one 3-pointer. Moritz Wohlers scored a game-high 28 points and grabbed eight rebounds. Cameron Munoz added 18 points, and Walker finished with 13. Carlin Hughes handed out eight assists.

In Friday's conference win over St. Mary's, Munoz knocked down seven 3-pointers and scored 27 points. Hughes finished with 25 points and dished out 11 assists. Wohlers added 21 points, and Buddy Windy Boy had 13. The win guaranteed the Yellowjackets of at least the #2 seed in the conference playoffs and clinched a first round home playoff game on March 1.

On Saturday the Jackets bounced back from Walker's fall with a barrage of 3-pointers. They hit five in a span of three minutes immediately following the incident and finished the game with 16. Wohlers scored a game-high 29 points on 10-of-18 shooting. Hughes made five 3-pointers and scored 28 points; he also handed out 14 assists. Munoz had another seven 3-pointers and scored 26. Munoz will enter this week needing just eight 3-pointers to tie the all-time NCAA Division II record of 443 career threes. He's also within 73 points of the school record for career points.

Craig Carse (11th year): Carse is in his eleventh season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. In the last 10 years the Jackets are 142-10 at Alterowitz Gym and have averaged 103.3 ppg at home. Carse entered the 2005-2006 season with a career 185-89 record at MSU-Billings, ranking second in school history for career victories. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for scoring for 3-point shooting. In the last 10 seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSU-Billings, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.8 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1987, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (2nd year): Dave Carse enters his second season as the Yellowjackets' assistant coach after playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets. David Carse will serve as the Yellowjackets' coordinator of recruiting, scouting and travel. He will also serve as Craig Carse's defensive coordinator and supervise team support staff. As a member of the NSCA, he directs the Yellowjackets' strength and conditioning as well as preseason skill work.
