Texas A&M-International

The Dustdevils are an NCAA Division II provisional member and a provisional member of the Heartland Conference. They will be one of the teams, along with Newman and Texas-Permian Basin, that will become members of the Heartland after the Yellowjackets leave for the Great Northwest Athletic Conference. The Jackets will face both TAMUI and UTPB this season per an agreement the Heartland made with those schools to be included in the conference scheduling. None of the provisional members are eligible for the conference championship, and games against them count the same as games against NAIA opponents. The Dustdevils are 3-1 to start the season, with wins over Universidad Regiomontana, Monterey Tech, and Texas Lutheran. Their lone loss came to Monterey Tech. Three players average double figures for scoring, led by Chris Swan's 15.5 points per game. Leon Jacob averages 13.5 ppg, and Martell Lewis adds 10.3 ppg. Tracy Johnson leads the team in rebounding at 7.0 rebounds per game. Point guard Angel Encinas leads the team in minutes played and is averaging 9.3 points, 6.0 assists, and 4.3 rebounds a game.

This will be the first-ever meeting between the two teams. MSUB and TAMUI will play twice this year, once in Laredo and once in Billings.

St. Mary's University

The Rattlers are expected to contend for the Heartland Conference crown this season. Friday's game between the Rattlers and Yellowjackets will be a non-conference counter. The Jackets will return to San Antonio in February for the conference game at STMU. The Rattlers are 3-3 and will be coming off two weeks of rest when they face the Yellowjackets. Of their three losses, two have come to Texas A&M-Kingsville, and the other was to 3rd-ranked Tarleton State. The Rattlers are only allowing 64.0 ppg and are out-rebounding their opponents by 9.5 rebounds a game. Robert Owens and Jawan Bailey each average 11.0 points and 5.8 rebounds a game. Jarvis Lee adds 8.7 ppg and leads the team in 3-point shooting. The same five players have started all six games this season.

The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets finally kicked off the 2006-2007 season last week at the Shilo Inn Classic in Nampa, ID. They dropped both games to future GNAC opponents, losing 92-63 to Central Washington and 88-74 to Northwest Nazarene.

In the season opener against Central Washington on Friday, the Wildcats tore to a 53-29 halftime lead and coasted to their third win of the year. Jonathan Wiley scored 20 points for the Yellowjackets, hitting 6-of-11 from the field and 7-of-8 from the line. MSUB shot just 33 percent as a team from the floor. Tom D'Amore scored 16 points in his collegiate debut. Jeff Miner added nine points. Carl Johnson scored five points and blocked a career-high three shots. Freshmen Mike Barton and Troy Ruff each scored their first collegiate points.

On Saturday the Jackets matched the host Crusaders for the opening minutes of the game, but NNU went on a shooting spree that opened a 50-38 halftime lead. For the second-straight night the Jackets played close to even with their opponent in the second half, but the first half deficit was too large to overcome. Miner netted a game-high 28 points. The freshman heir apparent to the 3-point gun-slinger role in the Jackets' offense was 5-of-8 from behind the arc. D'Amore was 5-of-7 from long range, finishing with 15 points. He was the only Yellowjacket to score in double figures both nights. Wiley, Johnson, and Cody Samuelson each had five rebounds.

Tip Ins

Since the Yellowjackets appeared in the Heartland Conference championship game last March, eight starters have come and gone. Three starters were lost to graduation last year, two more transferred to Division I schools, and three were dismissed from the team two weeks ago....Now in complete rebuilding mode, the Yellowjackets' weaknesses were revealed in last weekend's season-opening games. MSUB turned the ball over 38 times in two games and had a turnover margin of -7.0. On the defensive end of the floor, they were unable to get stops to create transition scoring opportunities. Both Central Washington and Northwest Nazarene shot over 58 percent from the field....One of the oddest stats from last weekend, at least on the surface, was rebounding. The Jackets out-rebounded both opponents despite losing by double digits both nights. But a closer look reveals that 34 of the Jackets' 74 rebounds came on the offensive end. Sophomore big man Carl Johnson averaged 4.5 offensive rebounds a game. Part of the explanation for the high percentage of offensive rebounds can be attributed to hustle on the offensive end. However, it didn't help the defensive rebounding stats when opponents were connecting on almost 60 percent of their field goal attempts....Speaking of anomalies, the Yellowjackets averaged fewer than 70 points a game last weekend, but three Yellowjackets—Jeff Miner, Tom D'Amore, and Jonathan Wiley—rank in the top 10 in the Heartland Conference for scoring. With just a nine-man roster, expect those three to get plenty of shots this season, particularly Miner, who averaged 18 shot attempts in last week's two games.

Craig Carse (12th year):



The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927.

Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.

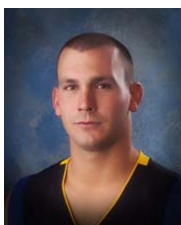
