This Week's Opponents:

West Liberty State College

The Hilltoppers, from West Liberty, WV, were the top scoring team in NCAA Division II last season with a 98.0 ppg average. They haven't missed a beat in their first seven games this season, averaging 105.7 ppg. They will bring a 5-2 overall record to Billings on Saturday. It will be just the second road game of the season for West Liberty, which is 3-1 at home, 1-1 on the road, and 1-0 at neutral sites.

The Hilltoppers have eclipsed 100 points four times in their first seven games. They opened the season with a 141-76 win against Ohio University Eastern. They have also scored 114 against West Virginia Wesleyan, 110 against Bethany, and 107 against Glenville State. In their two losses the Toppers only scored in the 80s.

As a team the Hilltoppers shoot 52 percent from the field and 38 percent from 3-point range. They've knocked down 66 threes in seven games for a 9.4 per game average. Although they aren't a big team, the Toppers have been effective at getting to the free throw line. They average 25 free throw attempts per game and about 17 percent of their scoring comes from the charity stripe.

As with any team that averages over 100 points a game, the Hilltoppers get points from a number of players in a number of ways. Five players average double figures for scoring. Corey McDuffie, a 6'0" senior guard, leads the way at 21.7 ppg. He also averages just under five rebounds a game. Shane Maynard, a 6'4" junior forward, adds 18.7 points and 5.6 rebounds a game. He scored 29 points in last week's win over Glenville State.

Sophomore guard Ben Howlett averages 14.9 points, mostly off the bench. Juniors Chris Banal and Dan Binggeli average 15.3 and 12.0 points respectively. Binggeli also has a team-high 34 assists with just 13 turnovers. McDuffie, Maynard, Banal, and Binggeli have each started all seven games. Four different players have shared the fifth starting spot.

The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets went on their second road trip in as many weeks to open the season. Following a two-game swing to Idaho to start December, MSUB played two games in Texas last week. They lost a heartbreaker, 59-58, on Wednesday at Texas A&M-International. On Friday they fell at St. Mary's University, 64-52.

After falling behind early to TAMIU on Wednesday in Laredo, the Yellowjackets rallied to take a 37-34 lead into halftime. There were three ties and eight lead changes in the second half with the Dustdevils leading by as many as nine and the Yellowjack-ets leading by as many as three. TAMUI took the lead for good with 5:01 to play at 59-58. That basket turned out to be the final points of the night for either team. The Yellowjackets missed six shots during the final five minutes and turned the ball over twice in the final five seconds.

Jeff Miner was 8-of-20 from the field and 3-of-12 from 3-point range for 20 points. As a team the Jackets hit 8-of-28 from behind the arc. Cody Samuelson scored 12 points and pulled down seven rebounds. Jonathan Wiley netted seven points and grabbed a team-high 10 rebounds. He also had three steals and blocked two shots. Freshman Troy Ruff also scored a career-high seven points off the bench.

The Yellowjackets fell to 0-4 with the 12-point loss at St. Mary's on Friday. They fell behind 34-21 at halftime and were unable to cut into the Rattlers' lead. MSUB outscored STMU 31-30 in the second half. Only five Yellowjackets scored in the game, led by Wiley's 17 points. Miner had 12 points to go with six rebounds. Ammar Harknell and Carl Johnson each had career highs with nine and eight points respectively. Samuelson finished with six points.

<u>Tip Ins</u>

The 2006-2007 season hasn't quite reached the quarter pole yet, but it appears that Yellowjacket fans will see a different style of basketball played at Alterowitz Gymnasium this season. After leading the nation in scoring in 1997, 1998, 2000, 2001, 2002, and 2003 with second-place finishes in 1999 and 2006, the Yellowjackets have averaged 61.8 points a game through their first four games this year. The reasons are simple. Since the end of last season, eight starters or potential starters have left the program for one reason or another. MSUB had only eight players available for last week's trip to Texas. Without the firepower to fire up 65 shots a game (last year's average), Coach Carse has slowed the tempo of the last few games. Saturday's game against West Liberty State was originally set up to pit the nation's top two scoring teams against each other. Now it may be a clash of styles with the Jackets trying to pull the reigns on the pace of the game.....Even though they're averaging almost 13 fewer 3-point attempts a game than they did last year, the Jackets are only getting to the line about 17 times a night. They averaged 25 free throw attempts per game last year. Even so, MSUB has still attempted more free throws than its opponents. A lot of the production at the line is coming from senior Jonathan Wiley. A career 80 percent free throw shooter entering the season, Wiley is 15-of-18 (83.3) so far this year.



The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927.

Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.
