Northwest Nazarene University

The Crusaders enter the week 3-6 overall and stand seventh in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference, the Jackets' conference beginning in 2007-2008. This will be the second meeting between these two teams this season. The Crusaders topped the Yellowjackets 88-74 at the Shiloh Inn Classic hosted by Northwest Nazarene in early December. Five different Crusaders notched double-digit points in that game.

Overall Justin Parnell is posting a team-leading 15.8 points per game averaging 2.67 three-pointers per game. Teammate Jason Simmons has averaged 15.1 points per game and his .667 field goal percentage and 6.8 rebounds per game land him first and eighth respectively in the GNAC. Although guard Louie Beech may stand only 6' 3", he leads the team in blocked shots with five. Beech has also hit just over 50 percent of his shots from long range, nailing 16-of-31 for the season so far.

The Crusaders are coming off a 109-76 win over Warner Pacific College last week, but have been unable to record back-to-back-wins thus far this season. As a team the Crusaders are shooting a solid 50 percent from the field and 44 percent from 3-point range. Despite dropping six of nine games, the Crusaders have higher overall field goal, three-point, and free throw percentages than they have allowed their opponents to shoot.

The Week in Review

With only eight players on the roster, Yellowjacket coaches have put together a variety of game plans this season. Early in the season, the Jackets burned seconds off the shot clock in an attempt to slow the pace. In Saturday's game against last year's No. 1 scoring team in the nation (the Jackets were No. 2) West Liberty State College, the Yellowjackets came out firing. The team hit four three-pointers in the first 3:45, jumping out to an 18-10 lead. The Hilltoppers turned the tide with their full court press and never let up. The Toppers forced 19 Yellowjacket turnovers in the first 20 minutes of play. At the half time buzzer, the Jackets were down 11.

The Jackets were able to get within six points just four minutes into the second half, but down the stretch the Toppers went on a 16-8 run to end the game, winning going away 103-85. Four Yellowjackets scored in double figures in the game paced by Jeff Miner's game-high 24 points. Miner was 9-of-26 from the field and 6-18 from behind the arc. Jonathan Wiley and Ammar Harknell each added 15 points with Harknell earning his first double-double with 13 rebounds. Teammate Carl Johnson netted a career-high 12 points.

Tip Ins

With Heartland Conference games just around the corner, it is tough to gage how the Jackets will stand up against their conference foes. The teams in the conference have combined for a 22-30 record with rival St. Edward's posting the only winning record thus far at 7-2...The Yellowjackets will open the conference season at home against Oklahoma Panhandle State on December 30. The Jackets beat the Aggies 80-67 in last season's Heartland Conference semifinal to go on to the conference title game...The Jackets' loss against West Liberty State College was the first time since 1998 that the Yellowjackets lost their home opener. The last loss to open the home schedule was a 103-100 barnburner against Albertson College in November of 1998...Freshman guard Jeff Miner from Gresham, Oregon has taken the reigns as points leader for the Jackets averaging 18.6 ppg, primarily from three-point range...Jonathan Wiley's experience and leadership have helped keep the Jackets organized on the court as he has now experienced both veteran players and newcomers to head coach Craig Carse's system. Wiley has averaged 13.6 ppg and leads the team with 6.6 rebounds per game. Wiley's three blocked shots this year have him in the top 10 in school history for a career with 42. He needs two more to move up to No. 8 all-time...Averaging just 18.8 minutes per game, Tom D'Amore has tallied 10 threes this season, shooting 35.7 percent from behind the arc. He is third on the team for scoring at 8.0 ppg.

The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927. Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.
