Oklahoma Panhandle State University

The Aggies opened the season with a win against New Mexico Highlands before losing seven in a row. They snapped that losing streak two weekends ago with a 79-67 win at Johnson & Wales, scoring 55 second half points.

The Aggies will bring a 2-7 record to Billings for their Heartland Conference opener on Saturday. Despite their –12.5 scoring margin, three of the Aggies' seven losses have been by 10 points or fewer. Their 50-point loss at Division I Oral Roberts didn't help their scoring average.

OPSU will be a different team than came to Billings last season. About half the team consists of junior college transfers new to the team this season, and there are four new freshmen. None of the 12 players who have seen action this season played in last year's Heartland Conference playoff game at MSU-Billings.

The trio of LaChawn Anderson, Fred Durr, and William Stephenson accounts for about 59 percent of the Aggies' scoring. Anderson, a 6'4" junior, is the only Aggie to start all eight games this year and leads the team at 15.1 ppg. He has led the team in scoring in five of nine games with a season-high 25 points in the win over New Mexico Highlands. The 6'7" Durr averages 11.7 ppg, and Stephenson adds 11.3. Stephenson, a 6'6" forward, is also the team's top rebounder at 8.0 rpg and has led the team in rebounding in eight games.

The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets hosted Northwest Nazarene for a pair of games in Billings to close out the non-conference portion of the schedule. They fell 70-50 on Wednesday and lost a 90-89 heartbreaker in overtime on Thursday. The losses dropped the Jackets to 0-7 overall and 0-3 at home.

On Wednesday Northwest Nazarene scored its first 18 points on 3-pointers, shooting over the Yellowjackets' zone. MSUB bounced back, using a 13-3 run at the end of the first half to take a 31-28 lead into the break. After taking a 35-30 lead in the first minute of the second half, the Yellowjackets scored just 15 points over the final 19 minutes of the game. The Crusaders outscored MSUB 42-19 in the second half to win going away. The Jackets' Jeff Miner scored 13 points on 4-of-15 shooting. Ammar Harknell came off the bench to score 12 points. Jonathan Wiley added seven points and grabbed a team-high eight rebounds.

Thursday's game was close wire to wire. The Yellowjackets led 33-30 at half-time. In the second half and overtime neither team led by more than four. There were six ties and 12 lead changes in the second half and another three ties and five lead changes in overtime. The Jackets' Harknell drained a 3-pointer to give MSUB a two-point lead with 24 seconds left in overtime, but the Crusaders answered with their own three in the final five seconds to steal the win. Wiley scored a career-high 30 points for the Yellowjackets, including nine of the team's 12 points in overtime. Fellow senior Cody Samuelson netted a career-high 20 points and grabbed nine rebounds. Tom D'Amore added 11 points, and Miner scored 10 to go with a season-high nine assists. Harknell finished with 12 points off the bench.

Tip Ins

Thursday's overtime affair against Northwest Nazarene was rare territory for the Yellowjackets. In the previous five seasons, MSUB only played three overtime games. They were 1-1 in overtime games in 2004-2005 and 0-1 in 2001-2002....The last time the Yellowjackets lost seven games to start a season was in 1965-1966. Hall of Fame coach Mike Harkins's crew lost their first nine games that season, but they went on to win 15 of their final 19 games. The following year they went to the NAIA national tournament....With only eight players on the roster, playing time will be plentiful for the Yellowjackets this year. Freshman Jeff Miner and senior Jonathan Wiley are each averaging 38 minutes per game. Senior Cody Samuelson isn't far behind at almost 34 minutes a game. Wiley averaged 20 minutes a game last year, and Samuelson played about 12 minutes a game. Miner was playing a 25-game high school schedule....Miner is getting plenty of on the job training to become the Yellowjackets' next 3-point shooter. Despite the fact that the Jackets are trying to slow down games this year, he is still attempting nine 3-pointers a game. In last year's run-n-gun offense, Cameron Munoz averaged 12 attempts a game.

The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927.

Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.
