#### This Week's Opponents:

#### Texas A&M University-International

The Dustdevils will bring a 6-5 record to Billings following an 88-64 win against Dallas Baptist on New Year's Day. The win snapped a four-game losing streak, which included a loss to Division I Texas State as well as a loss to HLC leader St. Edward's. In its first year of NCAA provisional membership, Texas A&M-International will count as a non-NCAA opponent for the Yellowjackets this season. Along with Newman and Texas-Permian Basin, TAMIU will become members of the Heartland Conference when MSUB moves to the GNAC next year.

The Dustdevils held on to defeat MSU-Billings in Laredo in early December. The Yellowjackets had two opportunities in the final seconds of the Dustdevils' 59-58 win, but turned the ball over both times.

Chris Swan, Angel Encinas, Martell Lewis and Leon Jacob each averages double figures. Swan leads the way at 13 ppg. Encinas, Lewis and Jacob each averages around 11 ppg. The trio of Swan, Encinas, and Jacob have combined for 50 steals in 11 games. The three scored 44 of the team's 59 points in the December win over MSUB. Tracy Johnson pulled down 20 rebounds in that win and averages 6.1 per game.

#### St. Edward's University

The Hilltoppers appear to be the team to beat in the Heartland Conference. They were picked first in the coaches' preseason poll, went 8-3 in non-conference games to start the season, and opened the conference schedule last Saturday with an 88-83 win against Dallas Baptist. SEU will play at Lincoln on Wednesday before traveling to Billings for a pair of games against the Yellowjackets. Saturday's game will count in the conference standings, and Sunday's will count as a non-conference game.

The defending league champs return a number of players from last year's team that went to the NCAA Tournament. The biggest loss from last year was the graduation of Heartland MVP David Lunn. Five of the Hilltoppers' top six scorers this season played on last year's squad. Shawn Weinstein leads the league in scoring at 18.8 ppg. Taylor Mullenax averages 12.4 points and a team-best 6.8 rebounds a game and leads the HLC in field goal percentage. Cornelius Gilleylen leads the league in steals and averages 6.4 ppg.

#### The Week in Review

Four players scored in double figures to lead the Jackets to their first victory of the season Saturday night. The Yellowjackets pulled away from a four-point halftime lead to down Oklahoma Panhandle State University 65-54 in the Heart-land Conference opener for both teams. A Jeff Miner 3-pointer with 6:16 to play in the first half gave the Yellowjackets a 28-27 lead. They extended that lead to as many as six before settling for a 36-32 halftime lead. The Jackets never trailed following Miner's 3-pointer, leading wire-to-wire in the second half. MSUB's largest lead of the game came with 1:13 to play following a pair of Jonathan Wiley free throws.

Wiley led four Jackets in double figures with 16 points. He was 5-of-10 from the field and 6-of-7 from the free throw line. Miner finished with 14 points, knocking down 2-of-6 from behind the arc. Wiley and Miner each had five assists, and Wiley pulled down seven rebounds. Carl Johnson had an efficient 11 points on 4of-9 shooting. He also blocked two shots and grabbed six rebounds. Cody Samuelson added 10 points and matched Wiley's seven rebounds for team-high honors. Tom D'Amore netted eight points, all coming in the second half. He hit both of his 3-pointers in a span of 1:40 midway through the second half to spark the Yellowjackets to their first double-digit lead of the game.

#### <u>Tip Ins</u>

January generally marks the beginning of conference play around the country. Some leagues start play a little before January, but conference schedules hit full swing once the New Year arrives. The Yellowjackets started their New Year off with a bang by downing OPSU. In the only other Heartland game so far, St. Edward's defeated Dallas Baptist 88-83. That puts SEU and MSUB at 1-0 in the league entering the first full week of conference games....If the Heartland had an Iron Man award, three Yellowjackets would be in contention for the honor. Jeff Miner, Jonathan Wiley, and Cody Samuelson rank first, second and fourth respectively in the conference for minutes played. Miner and Wiley are each averaging over 38 minutes a game....Statistically, Wiley is having the best season of his four-year career. He's second on the team and sixth in the conference for scoring at 15.1 ppg. He also leads the team in rebounding (6.6 rpg), free throws (47-of-60), and steals (10)....There won't be much rest for the Yellowjackets the remainder of the season. They play three games in four days in each of the next two weeks. There will be only one stretch in January or February with more than four days between games, and that six-day rest doesn't start until February 11. MSUB then plays three games in four days to end the regular season....Speaking of the schedule, there isn't a day of the week on which the Jackets won't play in the next two months. That will change next year when MSUB joins the Great Northwest Athletic Conference, which plays an 18-game conference schedule using a Thursday-Saturday format.

#### Craig Carse (12th year):



The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927.

Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.
