This Week's Opponents:

Oklahoma Panhandle State University

After making the Heartland Conference playoffs last year, the Aggies have stumbled to a 2-10 start overall this season. They are 0-3 in the conference following a pair of losses in Texas last week. OPSU's last win was on December 16 at Johnson & Wales.

Three Aggies average double figures, but the scoring drops off quickly after that. LaChawn Anderson leads the way at 15.1 points per game, fifth in the Heartland Conference. He also leads the team and ranks ninth in the conference for steals. Fred Durr adds 11.4 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. He leads the team in made 3-pointers and ranks fourth in the Heartland for made 3-pointers per game. William Stephenson averages 11.3 points and a team-best 7.1 rebounds a game. Anderson, Durr, and Stephenson combine for 60.6 percent of the Aggies' 62.4 ppg scoring average.

University of Texas-Permian Basin

The Falcons have not played a home game this season. They enter this week at 3-8 overall and will play two games before the Yellowjackets visit Odessa on Monday. UTPB plays another road game Tuesday at Texas-Pan American, an NCAA Division I opponent. Tuesday's game against UT-PanAm will already be the Falcons' third game this season against an NCAA Division I team. They lost to Rice and Texas State earlier in the season. On Saturday the Falcons play their home opener against Lincoln University (MO). UTPB is a provisional member of NCAA Division II in its first year of reclassification from NAIA. The Falcons will be members of the Heartland Conference once they become NCAA II members.

Mansour Mbye and Nedrie Simmons each average double figures. Mbye, a 6'5" senior from England, averages 15.4 points and 8.6 rebounds a game. He leads the team in both categories. Simmons, a 5'9" senior from Canada, averages 14.2 points per game and leads the team in 3-point shooting. The Falcons average 69.1 ppg while giving up 82.8. They are strong at the free throw line, shooting a combined 70.7 percent as a team.

The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets went 1-2 in three home games last week. They started with an 80-73 loss to Texas A&M-International on Thursday. MSUB split two games with St. Edward's over the weekend, winning 60-56 on Saturday and losing 91-60 on Sunday.

The Jackets' fourth-highest scoring output of the season wasn't enough in the loss to TAMIU. Tom D'Amore, Jeff Miner, and Ammar Harknell each scored 17 points. Jonathan Wiley added 13 points, and Cody Samuelson had seven. D'Amore and Harknell knocked down five 3-pointers apiece with D'Amore missing just once from behind the arc. Miner had three 3-pointers and led all players with 10 assists.

In a rematch of last year's Heartland Conference championship game, the Jackets shocked league favorite St. Edward's on Saturday behind Miner's 24 points. The freshman guard was 8-of-14 from 3-point range. Wiley finished with nine points while D'Amore, Samuelson, and Russell Steplight each had six. Eric Cunningham handed out seven assists. The win moved the Jackets into first place in the conference at 2-0.

The Jackets were overwhelmed early on in Sunday's non-conference loss to the Hilltoppers, trailing by double digits for almost 35 minutes of the game. Yellow-jacket fans did get a glimpse of what Steplight and Cunningham could do. The two were reinstated to the program on Saturday after being dismissed in November. On Sunday, Steplight scored 20 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field. Cunningham added 15 points and three assists. Miner finished with 10 points.

Tip Ins

When a team starts the season 2-9, they often try to find any positive area to build on. The Yellowjackets have to be encouraged by their two wins since they happened to come in their only two conference games thus far. That gives them the odd distinction of sitting atop the conference standings while posting an overall losing record. The goal for MSUB is to qualify for the Heartland Conference tournament, which takes the top four teams, and that is a possibility if they continue to win the games that count in the conference standings...In Saturday's conference win over St. Edward's, it seemed like a different Yellowjacket team stepped onto the court than had all season. Yes, the return of Russell Steplight and Eric Cunningham had something to do with it. But the Jackets played their best game of the season hands down, giving Jacket fans some encouragement...Freshman guard Jeff Miner gave fans a glimpse of what he's capable of on Saturday when he dropped in eight 3-pointers. Like every shooter, especially a freshman, Miner will have his ups and downs this year. Saturday was one of the ups as Miner took over the game in the second half, hitting six of his 3-pointers in the final 20 minutes.

Craig Carse (12th year):



The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927. Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.

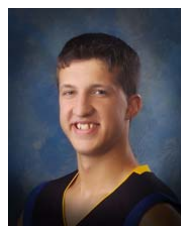
