St. Mary's University

The Rattlers will make the long trip to Billings for a lone Heartland Conference game on Wednesday. The Rattlers are 9-8 overall and 2-2 in the Heartland Conference following a 54-47 loss to St. Edward's University over the weekend. STMU has conference wins against Oklahoma Panhandle and Dallas Baptist. In addition to the loss to SEU, the Rattlers fell at home to Incarnate Word two weeks ago. St. Mary's defeated MSU-Billings 64-52 in a non-conference game in San Antonio on December 8.

The Rattlers' Jarvis Lee leads the team in scoring with 11.1 points per game. He is shooting 46 percent from the field and has knocked down a team-leading 34 three-pointers for a 47 percent efficiency. Jawan Bailey is averaging 9.1 points per game and leads the Rattlers in rebounding at 5.8 per game. Marcus Hill has been another consistent player for the Rattlers averaging 9.5 points and 4.1 rebounds per game. Hill scored 21 points in the win over the Yellowjackets in December. As a team, St. Mary's is shooting 49 percent from the field and 40 percent from 3-point range. The Rattlers have out-rebounded their opponents by an average of 4.7 rebounds per game.

University of the Incarnate Word

The Cardinals will enter the week at 8-9 overall and 3-2 in the conference. They'll play a conference game at Lincoln on Thursday before traveling to Billings for a pair of weekend games, a conference counter on Saturday and a non-conference game on Sunday. Under first-year coach Ken Burmeister, the Cardinals have shown marked improvement over last season when they went 8-19 overall and 0-12 in the Heartland Conference.

The Cardinals have been in a number of close games this season with 13 of their 17 decisions coming by 10 points or fewer. They have conference wins against Panhandle State, Dallas Baptist, and St. Mary's. Their two conference losses came at Dallas Baptist and at St. Edward's. Three different Cardinals average double figures for scoring, led by Jason Gant's 15.7 points per game. The 6'6' post player shoots over 50 percent from the field and averages a double-double with 10.1 rebounds per game. He's the leading rebounder and fourth-leading scorer in the Heartland. Mikyl Bradshaw and Pierce Caldwell also average double figures for scoring. Caldwell leads the team in 3-point shooting, connecting on 2.6 per game.

The Week in Review

The Jackets wrapped up a grueling four-game road trip with a 78-69 loss at Dallas Baptist on Wednesday. They bounced back to defeat Lincoln at home on Saturday, 95-84.

In the loss at DBU, the Jackets had one of their worst shooting halves of the year to fall behind 40-24 by halftime. Behind the 3-point shooting of Jeff Miner and Cody Samuelson, MSUB battled back to within six late in the game but had the rally fall short. Miner hit 9-of-25 threes in the game and finished with a career-high 29 points. Samuelson hit all three of his 3-pointers in the second half and scored 13 points in the game. Eric Cunningham netted a career-high 15 points to go with seven assists.

Despite Miner's absence on Saturday due to injury, the Jackets had their best offensive night of the year in the win over Lincoln. They shot 55 percent from the field and 41 percent from behind the arc. Tom D'Amore dropped in a careerhigh 29 points, hitting 8-of-16 from 3-point. Samuelson had a double-double of 16 points and 12 rebounds, and Cunningham posted a double-double with 13 points and 12 assists. Carl Johnson just missed a double-double with eight points and 10 rebounds. Jonathan Wiley finished with 15 points, and freshman Troy Ruff scored a season-high 11 points while hitting three 3-pointers.

Tip Ins

Approaching the midpoint of the Heartland Conference season, six of the seven teams are still battling for the four playoff spots. St. Edward's is in the driver's seat with a 4-1 league mark. Two teams, including the Yellowjackets, are tied at 3-2, one team is 3-3, one team is 2-2, and the sixth is 2-4. Lincoln is the only team without a conference win at this point at 0-3....It's probable that at least one of the four Heartland Conference playoff teams will go into the conference tournament with an overall losing record. At this point, only St. Edward's (13-4) and St. Mary's (9-8) have winning records. Incarnate Word is close at 8-9....MSU-Billings has gotten the most bang for its buck in the conference standings. Even though the Jackets are only 3-13 overall, all three of their wins have been conference wins and they are in the two-way tie for second place in the league standings entering the week....Point guard Eric Cunningham seems to be finding his stride. After missing last Saturday's game at Panhandle State because of injury, he has scored in double figures three-straight times. He scored a career-high 15 points to go with seven assists on Wednesday at Dallas Baptist. In Saturday's win against Lincoln he notched a double-double with 13 points and a dozen assists....When the Jackets' 3-point shooters are hitting on the same night, MSUB could be tough to stop. Miner drilled a season-high nine 3-pointers at Dallas Baptist on Wednesday; D'Amore buried eight in the win against Lincoln on Saturday; Samuelson had three triples in each of those games; and Ruff came off the bench to drop in three on Saturday.

The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927.

Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.


