#### This Week's Opponents:

#### St. Mary's University

The Rattlers, picked as one of the top two teams in the Heartland during the preseason, are battling to move up to the No. 2 spot for the conference playoffs. They currently sit third in the conference at 4-3 after losing to Incarnate Word last week 70-68. St. Mary's will enter the week at 11-9 overall and will host Montana State-Billings on Thursday and Lincoln on Saturday. The Rattlers defeated the Yellowjackets 67-51 in Billings on January 24. STMU is the top defensive team in the Heartland, allowing just 63.4 ppg.

Guard Jarvis Lee is the only Rattler averaging double figures for scoring at 11.8 points per game. He also leads the team in 3-point shooting, hitting 44-of-93 on the season. Lee scored 21 in the win at MSUB last month. Marcus Hill adds 9.5 ppg and is 23-of-49 from behind the arc. Seven different Rattlers average between five and eight points. Latez Williams, who averages 8.2 ppg, posted a double-double of 13 points and 13 rebounds in the win in Billings.

#### University of the Incarnate Word

The Cardinals have become the surprise team of the season in the Heartland. Picked to finish fifth after not winning a conference game last year, the Cardinals are just a half game out of first place in the conference at 6-2. They'll enter the week at 12-9 overall and will host Lincoln on Thursday and Montana State-Billings on Saturday. UIW has won nine of its last 11 games, including six of seven conference games. Chris Smith hit a 3-pointer with 10 seconds left to give the Cards a 70-68 win against St. Mary's last week.

Jason Gant, averaging a double-double of 15.2 points and 10.1 rebounds a game, has to be considered a player of the year candidate in the HLC. He had 22 points and 17 rebounds in one of the Cards' wins in Billings last month. Mikyl Bradshaw adds 12.1 ppg. Pierce Caldwell averages 11.2 ppg and leads the team with 55 three-pointers. Paul Connolly and Smith average 4.0 and 3.5 assists per game respectively.

#### The Week in Review

The Jackets split a pair of games at Lincoln University last weekend. On Friday they lost 80-71 in the conference counter. They bounced back for their first road victory of the season on Saturday, holding on to win 68-67.

On Friday, the Jackets pulled away from a halftime tie to lead by as many as eight in the second half. A 14-0 run by Lincoln late in the game turned the tables and handed MSUB its third-straight conference loss. Jeff Miner scored 17 points and picked up three steals. He was 4-of-14 from 3-point range; as a team the Jackets made 11-of-36 threes. Jonathan Wiley netted 13 points and grabbed seven rebounds. Cody Samuelson added a dozen points on 5-of-8 shooting.

On Saturday, starting guards Miner and Eric Cunningham had to sit out with injuries. The remaining eight Jackets responded with solid games. MSUB led by six at halftime and led wire-to-wire in the second half. After leading by as many as 11 in the final 20 minutes, the Jackets let the Tigers battle back to within a point in the final minute. Russell Steplight made a big basket in the final 40 seconds, and the Tigers missed three potential game-winning shots on the final possession. Wiley scored a game-high 22 points and dished out five assists with only one turnover. Freshman Troy Ruff added a career-high 16 points, and Samuelson scored nine of his 13 points in the second half.

#### Tip Ins

The injury sustained by Jeff Miner in Friday's loss will be season-ending. The freshman shooting guard averaged 16.0 points and 3.58 made 3-pointers a game in 19 games. He currently leads the Heartland Conference in 3-pointers per game and is second for scoring average. Miner also ranks in the top 20 in the nation for 3-pointers made. All of those rankings will disappear by the end of the season since he will not play in the required 75 percent of the team's games to be included in conference or NCAA statistical rankings. In 2003-2004, Cameron Munoz led the nation in 3-point shooting all season, but he missed seven games with injury and was dropped from the rankings in the final week....The races for the conference regular season title and the four conference tournament spots are heating up. St. Edward's and Incarnate Word are basically in a dead heat for first place with SEU at 5-1 and UIW at 6-2. Both control their own destiny. St. Mary's, Dallas Baptist, and MSU-Billings are all still alive for the final two spots in the conference tournament at 4-3, 4-4, and 3-5 respectively. The Jackets probably have to upset one of the top three teams on the road to set up a showdown with DBU in Billings for the fourth and final spot on February 19 ....Coach Craig Carse and the Yellowjackets will be holding a lunch on February 18 to honor seniors Jonathan Wiley and Cody Samuelson. #### Craig Carse (12th year):



The 2006-2007 season will be Coach Carse's twelfth at MSU-Billings, making him the second-longest tenured coach in the history of a program that began in 1927.

Carse's teams have posted winning seasons in 10 of his 11 years, giving him an overall record of 205-97 at MSU-Billings entering the 06-07 season. In 2005-2006 Carse guided the Yellowjackets to a share of the Heartland Conference regular season title and a runner up finish in the Heartland Conference playoffs. The Yellowjackets also led the nation in 3-pointers made for the seventh time in Carse's 11 years at the helm.


