Last Week

It was a tough go-around for the Yellowjackets in their last three games on the road in Texas. On October 13, the Jackets faced off against University of the Incarnate Word. The Cardinals (11-2-2) currently ranked No. 3 in the Midwest Region according to a recent NCAA poll, came on to the field with confidence. An inspired MSUB team kept the Cards on their heels for 83 minutes with a solid defensive game. A Yellowjacket foul set up the Cardinals Tom Morrill for a free kick. Morrill sent the ball past the Jackets line connecting with Miguel Hurtado in front of the net. Hurtado headed the ball into the left side of the goal with less than seven minutes remaining on the clock to give the Cards the 1-0 win.

The Jackets met St. Mary's (4-6-2) on October 15. Two goals in the first 27 minutes of play was enough for St. Mary's to take the win even though the Yellowjackets controlled the ball much of the game. MSUB narrowly missed two key shots in the game. One hit the post after a header and the other caromed off the crossbar denying the Jackets' goals that would have kept them in the game.

The Rattlers' Carlos Becerra scored an unassisted goal at 13:53 putting St. Mary's on the board. Just 13 minutes later Jonathan Gray crossed the ball to the middle of the field where Raul Davila made contact to head the ball past the Jackets' keeper giving the Rattlers the 2-0 lead that they never relinquished.

The final road game of the season found the Jackets squaring up against St. Edward's University (6-4-3). In the 70th minute of regulation, the Jackets' Jarred Weisen (Great Falls, MT) broke the scoreless tie on an unassisted goal, his third of the season. At 82:58 the Hilltoppers' Jesse Leos evened the score volleying the ball to the corner of the net on an assist from teammate Beau Grantier.

Tied at one a piece both teams were probably expecting to duke it out in overtime but with just 39 seconds to play, Topper Jonathan McQuade gave a through ball to Harrison Nance who crossed it in front of the Jackets' goal where Christopher Burrell connected icing the win for the Hilltoppers.

Noe Pantoja and Jonathan Callahan. Pantoja has posted a 0.75 goals against average allowing three goals this season. Callahan has allowed 19 goals in eight games for a 2.71 GAA. The last time these two teams met in Texas, it was sunny and hot. Will the Dustdevils have the same result, or will the north wind freeze their scoring?

University of Texas—Permian Basin

For a team in their first season as a NCAA-II provisional member, the Falcons could not have asked for much more. Permian Basin (6-7-2) is currently ranked 10th in the Midwest region based on a recent NSCAA poll. The Falcons are led by Josh Steward and Carlos Guillen with eight and seven goals respectively. Guillen leads the team in assists with five. Jose Soto is third on the Falcons' lineup with five goals and an assist. Goalkeeper Gage Peterson has a 1.64 goals against average off 23 goals and has recorded 104 saves for a .819 save percentage. The last time the Jackets and Falcons met in Odessa, the Falcons edged the Jackets 1-0.

Corner Kicks

Sam Charles continues to be a leader among the Heartland Conference elite ranking second for shots taken and shots per game with 50 and 3.12 respectively...Charles also ranks fourth with 13 points and for goals scored with six...Jarred Weisen has come alive the second half of the season posting three goals in eleven games tying teammate Greg McKeever and others to rank 10th for points scored...Jay Doogan's three assists ties him for fourth in the HLC...as a team, the Yellowjackets are tied for first in school history for shutouts with three....one more win this season would tie last year's result of five.
