Last Week

With hopes of a winning season, the Montana State-Billings men's soccer team went 0-1-2 to open the 2006 season on a three-game swing through Colorado.

The Jackets played at Colorado State-Pueblo to open their three-game road trip. Following a 30-minute start delay due to lightning and the officials calling the game four-seconds into the second overtime on account of darkness, the Yellowjackets settled for a 0-0 tie. Goalkeeper Sander Tollefson (Missoula, MT) made seven saves in his collegiate debut, keeping the Jackets alive allowing the offense to do their part. Brian Huskey (Billings, MT), Matt D'Hont (Rapid City, SD), and Sam Charles (Chiswell, England) each had a shot on goal while teammate Jay Doogan (Glasgow, Scotland) went at the Thunderwolves' keeper twice.

Sandwiched between teams in which the Jackets lost to a year ago was a game against Colorado Christian University. The game was almost an exact repeat of the game against Pueblo. The Cougars were ahead by one when the officials called for a lightning delay at 69:10 into the game. Following the 45-minute delay the teams were back on the field. In the 78th minute, the Jackets' Charles tied the game on a penalty kick which was also his first collegiate goal. Neither team could capitalize in the double overtime resulting in the 1-1 tie.

The Jackets out shot the Cougars 17 to 12 with seven shots on goal to Colorado Christians six. Tollefson posted five saves allowing just one goal. That goal came from the Cougars' Tim Lowe with Mitchell Harty picking up the assist.

In the final game of the road trip, the Jackets played Regis University in Denver Monday. Two double overtime games in four days took its toll on the Jackets as they lost to the Rangers 2-0. The Jackets had just two shots on goal and three saves.

Coach McNally's Comments

"We have made a solid start to the season," said head coach Dan McNally. "Ten players made their MSU-Billings debut this weekend and will only get better as they gain experience."

"This week in practice we will work on our offensive production and creating chances to score," added McNally. "Overall I am pleased with the way things are going and we need to get a win this weekend."

University of the Incarnate Word

The Cardinals were picked atop the Heartland Conference standings in a recent poll of coaches and sports information directors. The NCSAA also ranked Incarnate Word as the 19th best team in the nation in division II. Finishing the 2005 season 14-4-3 overall and 11-1-2 in the conference—taking the title—the Cardinals return 12 of 26 players. They are led by Miguel Hurtado who raked in six goals last season to go with three assists. Goalkeeper Gil Ben Nachum had 79 saves and an impressive 0.79 goals against average. Incarnate Word defeated the Jackets in San Antonio 1-0 the last time these two teams met. The Cardinals are 1-0-0 to start the 2006 season.

The Rattlers are returning 14 of 25 players from the 2005 roster accounting for 24 of the teams goals. St. Mary's finished last season 6-11-0 overall and 4-10-0 in the Heartland Conference and are picked to finish third in the HLC preseason poll. Scott Kilpatrick leads the Rattlers offensive charge posting seven goals last season. Aaron Ruiz had three goals and led the team with five assists.
