Last Week

The Yellowjackets ended their four-game losing streak by picking up back-to-back wins last week against College of the Southwest in Odessa, Texas and Colorado Christian University at home at the College of Technology Field.

In the game against the College of the Southwest, five different Yellowjackets scored in the 5-1 neutral site win. Jurell Linford (Missoula, MT) picked up his first goal of the season with teammate Jared Weisen (Great Falls, MT) scoring his first collegiate goal. Sam Charles (Chiswell, England), Josh Hernandez (Palmdale, CA), and Greg McKeever (Kirkland, WA) each added a goal in the team's convincing win. The five goals and four assists in the game placed the Jackets fourth in school history for total points in a single game with 14. Jay Doogan (Glasgow, Scotland) had two assists in the game which tied him for first in school history for assists in a single game.

"It was a great performance today," said Yellowjacket head coach Dan McNally. "The team rebounded from the previous losses and for the first time they looked dangerous on offense. Hopefully our momentum from this result will carry over to our game against Colorado Christian on Saturday."

The momentum did carry over as the Yellowjackets downed the Cougars 4-0, winning in shutout fashion on Saturday. Charles added two more goals to his stats sheet bringing him to an even six on the season. Teammates Matt D'Hont (Rapid City, SD) and Jeremy DeHerrera (Kalispell, MT) each scored their first goals of the season with DeHerrera's being his first collegiate.

"Sam (Charles) placed the ball well for me and I was able to put it in the corner," said an elated Matt D'Hont. "We have gained our confidence back and our determination will help carry us into our upcoming games. With the way the team is playing and the goals that are going in along with our defense playing how they are, I think the game against Mary will be the game that will give us the back-to-back-to-back win," added D'Hont.

A win over University of Mary on Friday would give the Jackets three consecutive wins, a feat that has not been accomplished since the 2003 season.

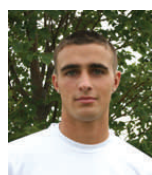
Metro State University

The Roadrunners, currently ranked fifth in the Midwest region, are 7-4-1 on the season. Metro played Heartland Conference schools in their last two games without posting a win. In fact, Metro has failed to score a goal in their last three outings. They will be looking to change their fortune this weekend. The Roadrunners lost a 5-0 shut-out against University of the Incarnate Word and a double overtime game against St. Edward's University produced at 0-0 tie. The Roadrunners' Antonio Porras and Shaun Elbaum have six goals a piece with a total of nine players contributing goals to the team this season. Goalkeeper Ryan Vickery has seen the majority of time in the net recording 34 saves and has a goals against average of 1.17.

Corner Kicks

Sam Charles is tied for second in the HLC with 36 shots, averaging 3.27 per game...Charles is ranked third in the conference with six goals and is third with 13 points...Goalkeeper Sander Tollefson is third in the HLC with a 1.47 GAA...Tollefson holds the No. 2 spot in the conference with 46 saves, averaging 4.6 per game...The Jackets have posted two shutouts and are ranked second in the Heartland Conference for goals scored with 13.
