Last Week

It was a busy weekend at the College of Technology Field with three games being played October 6-8. The Yellowjackets hosted University of Mary on Friday and Metro State College on Sunday with a neutral game between Mary and Metro sandwiched in between on Saturday.

In Friday's game both the Marauders and the Yellowjackets were evenly matched teams through the first 45 minutes of play with both keepers making two saves. The Jackets out-shot the Marauders by two in the first half but came out on the offensive in the second half overpowering the Marauders with 10 shots, three of which were on goal.

Twenty minutes into the second half, Jeremy DeHerrera (Kalispell, MT) narrowly missed scoring on a perfectly set header, but continued pressure by the Jackets paid off with just 11 minutes to play in regulation. On a push toward the Marauders net, Jurell Linford (Missoula, MT) gave a through ball to Jay Doogan (Glasgow, Scotland) who then crossed the ball to Jarred Weisen (Great Falls, MT). Weisen took the ball, firing on the Marauders net from three yards out to score the game-winning goal, edging Mary 1-0.

"It was crucial that we win the game today," said Yellowjacket head coach Dan McNally. "We needed to keep our good form going. It wasn't our best performance but we kept it together and defended the ball well. We made some changes up front it paid off with the win. Overall I am very pleased," added McNally.

Saturday's game was one of spirited wills between the Yellowjackets and Metro State Roadrunners. The Yellowjackets struck first against the Roadrunners off a corner kick by Greg McKeever (Kirkland, WA). McKeever sent the ball sailing to the left corner where Jeremy DeHerrera connected with the ball mid-air to score at the 7:07 mark.

Just five minutes later, the Roadrunners would even the score. Mark Cromie's free kick crossed to Wynne Mason who tied the game at one apiece. The Roadrunners, playing one man short following a red card just before halftime, kept the Jackets scoreless as MSUB controlled the tempo much on the second half.

At the 5:04 mark of the first overtime, Metro's Sam Rolph crossed the ball to Phillip Owen from deep left of the net. Owen caught Jackets' keeper Sander Tollefson (Missoula, MT) off balance, winning 2-1 by golden goal.

Incarnate Word

The No. 8 Cardinals are coming off a 3-1 loss to No. 5 nationally ranked Fort Lewis College last week. The Cards are led by Esteban Bayona and John Ballantyne who have scored 11 and 10 goals respectively. Both Bayona and Ballantyne lead the HLC in scoring. Cards' keeper Gil Ben Nachum has only posted 42 saves as a result of Incarnate Word's defense. Allowing just 13 goals all season, Nachum's GAA is 0.92 following a conference leading four shutouts.

St. Mary's

The Rattlers (3-6-2) are coming off a 2-0 upset win over number nine regionally ranked West Texas A&M Friday. Chris Vaughn and Chris Smith paired up for the Rattlers two goals in the shutout win. In fact, all three of the Rattlers wins have come in the form of shutouts.

Vaughn and Raul Davila lead the team with two goals apiece while Rattlers' keeper Brett Collier has a 1.56 goals against average posting 60 saves for a .769 save percentage. The Jackets downed St. Mary's 2-1 in Billings on September 3rd. Will there be a repeat, or can St. Mary's change their fortune against the Jackets' offense?

St. Edward's

The Hilltoppers 4-2 record following the first six games of the season skidded to a stop as they have been unable to put away a win in their last four outings as all have resulted in ties. The Hilltoppers are led by Kevin Klaus with four goals and John Calandro with three. Beau Grantier leads the team in assists with three. Goal keeper Chris Sanders leads the HLC with just eight goals scored against him for a 0.74 GAA. Sanders has also recorded 45 saves and four shutouts. In early September, the Hilltoppers edged the Jackets 1-0 at the COT.

Jarred Weisen was named HLC Offensive Player of the Week...Sam Charles leads the conference with 46 shots and 3.54 shots per game average...Charles is ranked third for both points and goals with 13 and six respectively...Jay Doogan ranks fourth in the HLC for assists with three...keeper Sander Tollefson is second in the conference recording 53 saves...as a team, the Jackets rank second for goals scored with 15, and second for assists with 10...the Yellowjackets three shutouts on the season thus far ties them for first in school history for shutouts in a single season.
