The Race Is On

With the Yellowjackets' doubleheader sweep of Hawaii-Hilo on Sunday, the PacWest title chase became a lot tighter. It could have opened the door for second place Hawaii Pacific, but the Sea Warriors split with BYU-Hawaii on Saturday. Monday's results in Billings could make things even more interesting in the PacWest. The remaining conference games for the top three teams include UH-Hilo at MSU-Billings (4/11), Hawaii Pacific at Chaminade (4/16), Hawaii Pacific at UH-Hilo (4/23), Chaminade at Hawaii Pacific (4/24) and Western New Mexico at MSU-Billings (4/30 & 5/1). The winner of the conference crown will earn an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament. If the second place team finishes strong, it could receive an at large bid.

Cenex High Octane

Cenex Stadium lived up to its reputation for home runs on Sunday as MSU-Billings and Hawaii-Hilo combined for seven long balls in the two games. The Yellowjackets hit four of the seven, including two from senior Theresa Campbell. "Soup" homered once in each game to move into a tie for the PacWest home run lead with eight on the season. Fellow senior Layne Pavey went yard in the second game to remain one home run ahead of Campbell on the Yellowjacket career list.

Century Club

Campbell and Pavey each reached 100 career hits with their home runs on Sunday. That makes five Yellowjackets in the program's short history to collect at least 100 hits. Cami Rainey tops the list with 139, followed by Joey Ehnes with 136 and Sara Hanley with 127. The next in line to join the century club will be junior Christy Wankel, who has 96.

A Rainey Week in Billings

Yellowjacket senior Cami Rainey was named the Pacific West Conference player of the week on Monday. The shortstop from Terreton, Idaho, led the Yellowjackets to a 5-1 conference mark for the week, including a pair of upsets of first place Hawaii-Hilo on Sunday. The Yellowjackets' leadoff hitter batted .571 for the week, scoring 10 runs and driving in four RBI. She had a .905 slugging percentage with five extra base hits—four doubles and a home run. For the season, Rainey ranks second in the PacWest with a .424 batting average and sixth with a .616 slugging percentage. Her 34 runs scored are second in the league, and she leads the PWC for total hits with 53.

Yellowjacket Coaching Staff



Jeff Aumend is in his fifth season at the helm of the Yellowjacket program that he built from the ground beginning in 2000. At MSU-Billings, Aumend has again taken a program from scratch and made it competitive in just a few years. The Yellowjackets won 18 of their last 24 games, last year, to finish just one game below .500 at 27-28. The 2004 season was full of highlights as they led the Pacific West Conference in home runs and had six players named all-conference with two of those also being named all-region. A 53-92 overall record for the program is deceptive as the Jackets have increased, progressively, from 2 wins in 2001 to 9 (2002), 15 (2003) and 27, last season.

Aumend, a native of Alliance, Ohio, started the NCAA Division II women's softball program at Queens College in Charlotte, North Carolina in 1994 and served as its first and only Head Women's Softball Coach until he moved to Billings in September of 2000 to start the MSU-Billings softball program. In his seven years at Queens College, Aumend achieved a 155-132 record with a 100% graduation rate among his student-athletes. In Aumend's first season at Queens College (1993-94), the Royals posted a 26-17 record. More recently, in the 1997 season, the Royals went 32-13 and finished the season ranked fourth in the South Atlantic Region. Aumend earned his 200th career victory last season and has an eleven-year career record of 208-224. A respected hitting coach, his 1998 team at Queens finished fourth in the nation in team batting average at .372 and last year's MSU-Billings finished 23rd in the nation home runs with 32.

MSU-Billings competes in the Pacific West Conference, which includes four schools in Hawaii and one in New Mexico. MSU-Billings is the first four-year institution in Montana to offer women's softball. Aumend received a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication Arts from Defiance College (Ohio). He currently serves on the NCAA Division II "Top 25" poll committee and is the former National Chairperson for Education/Publications for the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).
