Last Week's Highlights:

Montana State-Billings pitcher **Joey Ehnes** kicked off her senior campaign with a big weekend and earned PacWest Player of the Week honors on Monday. Ehnes, a pitcher/infielder from Great Falls, MT, helped the Yellowjackets go 3-2 at the St. Cloud State Husky Dome Classic. The two losses were to 4th-ranked St. Cloud State and 19th-ranked Emporia State. Ehnes was 3-1 with a 1.71 ERA in five appearances. She pitched 28 2/3 innings and struck out 45 batters with just five walks. Her only loss of the week was a 2-1 decision to Emporia State. Ehnes already holds every pitching record in the program's history. Her 45 Ks pushed her over the 400 mark for her career with 413. At the plate, Ehnes batted .400 in five games. She was 6-for-15 with two runs and two RBI. She also drew two walks and stole a base.

The Yellowjackets opened their season Saturday by winning two of three games at the St. Cloud State Husky Dome Classic. The Yellowjackets defeated Pittsburg State in the first game of the day, 8-3. **Joey Ehnes** earned the win. She went the distance, striking out 12 while allowing just six hits. Seven different players collected the Jackets' seven hits in the game. **Sara Hanley** was 1-for-3 and scored three runs. **Jenna Haacke** was 1-for-2 with a run and a pair of RBI. **Theresa Campbell** and **Christy Wankel** each homered. Campbell drove in three RBI, and Wankel plated two.

MSU-Billings fell to host St. Cloud State, 5-3 in game two. The Huskies are currently ranked fourth in the nation. **Megan McCrae** took the loss, giving up three runs in three innings. Ehnes finished the game, allowing two runs. The Jackets trailed 5-0 after the fourth inning, but rallied to score three runs in the final two innings. Haacke was 2-for-4 with a pair of RBI. Hanley, Campbell and **Cami Rainey** each scored a run. **Stephanie Cochrun** went 2-for-3.

The Jackets rebounded for a 7-6 victory over Winona State in nine innings in the nightcap. Ehnes (2-0) earned the victory in relief and scored the winning run in the bottom of the ninth inning. Each team scored five runs in the first inning before the pitchers settled down. The Jackets' **Jordan Waverek** (Sr., Kalispell, MT) gave up two hits and five runs in a third of an inning before being relieved by Ehnes. The Warriors' Kristen Fossell gave up six runs on six hits in an inning and a third before being relieved.

Using the international tiebreaker rule, Ehnes opened the bottom of the ninth placed on second base. She was sacrificed to third by Rainey. With Hanley at the plate, Winona State's catcher tried to pick off Ehnes at third, but the ball sailed into left field and Ehnes scored the game winner. Wankel was 3-for-4 with three RBI and a run scored in the game. Rainey was 2-for-5 with a run scored. **Rachel Quarnburg** went 1-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored. Ehnes also struck out 12 batters in the win over Winona State, falling just one short of her own school single game record of 13.

The Jackets finished their opening weekend with a two game split on Sunday at the Husky Dome Classic. The Yellowjackets dropped the morning game to 19th-ranked Emporia State, 2-1. They rebounded with a 2-0 shutout of Minnesota-Duluth. In Sunday's 8:00 a.m. game, Emporia State jumped to a 2-0 lead just three batters into the game when Courtney Stevens hit a two-run home run off Yellowjacket starter **Joey Ehnes**. Ehnes took control of the game from that point, scattering five hits over seven innings and striking out 11. She still suffered her first loss of the season to fall to 2-1 as the Yellowjacket offense didn't offer much support. **Cari Dunlap** scored in the bottom of the second for the Yellowjackets after pinch running for **Theresa Campbell** (Sr., Great Falls, MT), who had singled. Batting in the ninth spot, Ehnes drove in Dunlap for MSUB's only run. Ehnes was 1-for-2 at the plate. Campbell went 2-for-4, and **Christy Wankel** went 2-for-3.

The Yellowjacket pitching dominated the day's second game against Minnesota-Duluth. **Jordan Waverek** tossed four scoreless innings, striking out three and allowing two hits. Ehnes (3-1) pitched the final three innings in relief, giving up two hits and striking out four. For the weekend, Ehnes threw 28 2/3 innings and struck out 45 with a 1.71 ERA. MSU-Billings got on the board in the top of the fifth inning when **Megan McCrae** singled to drive in Ehnes from third. The Jackets added an insurance run in the top of the seventh. Ehnes doubled with one out, and **Aysha Blatter** singled to plate Ehnes for her second run of the game.

Yellowjacket Coaching Staff



Jeff Aumend is in his fifth season at the helm of the Yellowjacket program that he built from the ground beginning in 2000. At MSU-Billings, Aumend has again taken a program from scratch and made it competitive in just a few years. The Yellowjackets won 18 of their last 24 games, last year, to finish just one game below .500 at 27-28. The 2004 season was full of highlights as they led the Pacific West Conference in home runs and had six players named all-conference with two of those also being named all-region. A 53-92 overall record for the program is deceptive as the Jackets have increased, progressively, from 2 wins in 2001 to 9 (2002), 15 (2003) and 27, last season.

Aumend, a native of Alliance, Ohio, started the NCAA Division II women's softball program at Queens College in Charlotte, North Carolina in 1994 and served as its first and only Head Women's Softball Coach until he moved to Billings in September of 2000 to start the MSU-Billings softball program. In his seven years at Queens College, Aumend achieved a 155-132 record with a 100% graduation rate among his student-athletes. In Aumend's first season at Queens College (1993-94), the Royals posted a 26-17 record. More recently, in the 1997 season, the Royals went 32-13 and finished the season ranked fourth in the South Atlantic Region. Aumend earned his 200th career victory last season and has an eleven-year career record of 208-224. A respected hitting coach, his 1998 team at Queens finished fourth in the nation in team batting average at .372 and last year's MSU-Billings finished 23rd in the nation home runs with 32.
