Seattle University – The Redhawks, last year's GNAC runner up, were 4-4 at last weekend's Central Washington Invitational. They defeated Western Oregon, Northwest Nazarene, Western Washington, and Grand Canyon and lost to Humboldt State, St. Martin's, Central Washington, and MSU-Billings. The loss Sunday to the Yellowjackets marked the first time MSUB had defeated the Redhawks. Seattle didn't hit particularly well over the weekend, batting .177 as a team, but it was just their first weekend of competition. Amanda Nilles and Jane Purdy each batted .238.

<u>Saint Martin's College</u> – The Saints are 4-8 after finishing the Central Washington Invitational with a four game losing streak. One of those losses was a 9-2 defeat to MSU-Billings. Tamara Mickelson is batting .306 with five runs and five RBI. Pitcher Tana Lingl has been the winning pitcher in all four of the Saints' victories and has a 1.96 ERA with 32 strikeouts in 35 innings.

<u>Dickinson State University</u> – The Blue Hawks will be playing their first official game of the season on Sunday when they visit Cenex Stadium for a single game at 1:30 p.m. That game will be the home opener for the Yellowjackets. Following Sunday's game in Billings, Dickinson flies to Tucson, AZ, where they will face eight teams over 11 days. The Blue Hawks return seven players from last year who batted over .300. Infielder Heather Barrett hit. .367 and scored 28 runs. Outfielder Tiffany Saatzer batted .376 with a .419 on base percentage.

Last Week's Highlights:

A Rainey Weekend in Washington:

Senior shortstop Cami Rainey made her final trip to the Central Washington Invitational a memorable one. She went 14-of-28 from her leadoff spot with a team-best nine RBI and eight runs scored. She also belted two home runs and three doubles in the eight games. Her walk off homer in the bottom of the seventh gave the Yellowjackets their first ever win against Seattle University, 4-3 on Sunday. The Redhawks were 26th in the NFCA preseason poll. How good has Rainey been so far this season? She has batted .417 to raise her career average to a school record .316. Her performance in Richland was enough to raise her career average an incredible 16 points.

500 Club:

Along with Rainey's .500 average at last weekend's tournament, Rachel Quarnburg and Joey Ehnes also batted .500 for the eight games. Each of them went 10-for-20 at the plate. Quarnburg drove in seven RBI and scored a pair of runs. She also hit her first home run as a Yellowjacket in the win over Western Oregon. In the win against Northwest Nazarene, she hit two doubles. Ehnes scored eight times over the weekend and drove in four RBI. She also slapped two triples and a pair of doubles. With their big weekends, Ehnes, Quarnburg and Rainey lead the team in batting with averages over .400. Ehnes is hitting .457 followed by Quarnburg at .433 and Rainey at .417.

Pitching Wins Championships:

That phrase is particularly true in Division II where a team with a dominating pitcher can go a long way in the NCAA Tournament. Yellowjacket coaches had two reasons to smile about their pitching last week. First, four pitchers combined for a 1.69 ERA in eight games. Second, ace Joey Ehnes didn't have to throw all 54 innings. Senior Megan McCrae, who struggled with her control last season, was a model of efficiency in two starts in Richland. She went 2-0 with a 0.58 ERA and two complete game victories. She allowed just six hits and one earned run in 12 innings and held opposing hitters to a .150 average. Most impressive was the fact that she didn't walk a batter.

Home Sweet Home....well, maybe:

The Jackets host Dickinson State on Sunday in their 2005 home opener. First pitch for the single game is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. Mother Nature must be keeping an eye on the Jackets' schedule as well. After weeks of temps in the 50s and 60s, the forecast for this Sunday actually calls for snow showers. The next home game is scheduled for April 5 against Chaminade.

Yellowjacket Coaching Staff



Jeff Aumend is in his fifth season at the helm of the Yellowjacket program that he built from the ground beginning in 2000. At MSU-Billings, Aumend has again taken a program from scratch and made it competitive in just a few years. The Yellowjackets won 18 of their last 24 games, last year, to finish just one game below .500 at 27-28. The 2004 season was full of highlights as they led the Pacific West Conference in home runs and had six players named all-conference with two of those also being named all-region. A 53-92 overall record for the program is deceptive as the Jackets have increased, progressively, from 2 wins in 2001 to 9 (2002), 15 (2003) and 27, last season.

Aumend, a native of Alliance, Ohio, started the NCAA Division II women's softball program at Queens College in Charlotte, North Carolina in 1994 and served as its first and only Head Women's Softball Coach until he moved to Billings in September of 2000 to start the MSU-Billings softball program. In his

seven years at Queens College, Aumend achieved a 155-132 record with a 100% graduation rate among his student-athletes. In Aumend's first season at Queens College (1993-94), the Royals posted a 26-17 record. More recently, in the 1997 season, the Royals went 32-13 and finished the season ranked fourth in the South Atlantic Region. Aumend earned his 200th career victory last season and has an eleven-year career record of 208-224. A respected hitting coach, his 1998 team at Queens finished fourth in the nation in team batting average at .372 and last year's MSU-Billings finished 23rd in the nation home runs with 32.

MSU-Billings competes in the Pacific West Conference, which includes four schools in Hawaii and one in New Mexico. MSU-Billings is the first four-year institution in Montana to offer women's softball. Aumend received a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication Arts from Defiance College (Ohio).
