Next Week's Opponents:

Hawaii Pacific University – The Sea Warriors are one of four likely contenders for the PacWest crown this year. They are 18-8 overall and 3-3 in the conference after Monday's split with Western New Mexico. The Sea Warriors and Mustangs play another doubleheader on Tuesday before HPU hosts the Yellowjackets on Thursday. Hawaii Pacific has relied on an infusion of young talent this year. Two of the Sea Warriors' eight freshmen have already been named PacWest players of the week and the eight entered the week with a combined batting average of .386. Freshmen Kellie Nishikida and Nicole Kalakau are each hitting over .400 and have already combined for 39 RBI. Freshman Brandi Peiler leads the league with five home runs and is also hitting .342.

The Jackets won three of four games against HPU last year, but the Sea Warriors finished their trip to Billings with a 17-3 shellacking of the Jackets at Cenex Stadium. MSUB is 1-9 all-time at HPU.

Brigham Young University-Hawaii – The Seasideers stumbled out of the gate but have rebounded to improve to 11-15. They are 3-7 in the PacWest after spitting with Chaminade on Monday. Mandy Kirkham is batting .356 with 15 runs scored. Freshman Stephanie Pane'e leads the team with 12 RBI. Brooke Hilton and Echo Allred are a combined 7-10 on the rubber, combining for 63 strikeouts in 121 innings.

MSU-Billings has won three of the last four meetings in a series dominated by the home teams. The Jackets are 6-2 against the Seasideers at Cenex Stadium, but have not won in six tries in Laie. BYU-Hawaii will host Western New Mexico for a pair of doubleheaders at the end of this week before the Seasideers host the Yellowjackets next Monday and Tuesday.

Notes

Aloha:

After an 11 day break in the schedule, the Yellowjackets will finally hit the field again on Thursday when they open their Pacific West Conference schedule with a doubleheader at Hawaii Pacific University. The team flew out of Billings Tuesday morning and won't return until after the Easton Tournament of Champions in Modesto, CA on April 1-3. While in the islands, the Yellowjackets are schedule to face Hawaii Pacific four times and BYU-Hawaii four times. Historically the trip to Hawaii has not been kind to the Jackets. They have a combined 1-33 record in Hawaii with their only win coming two years ago at Hawaii Pacific. However, the games in Hawaii are usually the first of the season for the Yellowjackets, who haven't hit much live pitching before opening the conference schedule. This time around MSU-Billings is off to the best start in school history at 13-5. That record includes a 9-3 mark against West Region opponents. A successful trip to the islands would position the Yellowjackets to contend for the PacWest title and an NCAA Tournament bid.

Aloha (the other kind):

When the Yellowjackets fly out of Honolulu next week, it will likely be for the last time. At the very least it will be the last trip to Hawaii for a PacWest Conference game. The Jackets will move to the Heartland Conference beginning next season, trading the once a year trip to Hawaii for a couple trips to Texas. Current PacWest foe Western New Mexico—who is also on its annual Hawaii trip this week—will join the Jackets in the Heartland next year.

What a Difference a Year Makes:

Through the first 18 games of this season, MSU-Billings has an overall winning percentage of .722. At the same juncture last year the Yellowjackets were 4-14 for a .222 winning percentage. Included in those 14 losses were eight-straight conference games in Hawaii.

Ducks on the Pond:

Of the Yellowjackets with at least 30 at bats this season, four have higher batting averages with runners on base than they do with the bases empty. Rachel Quarnburg is hitting a blistering .536 with runners on base. Of course, so far this year she is hitting well in every situation. She has a solid .429 average with the bases empty. Joey Ehnes is batting .480 with runners on base (.360 empty). Sara Hanley is hitting .257 compared to .211, and Jenna Haacke is hitting .206 compared to .176.

Yellowjacket Coaching Staff



Jeff Aumend is in his fifth season at the helm of the Yellowjacket program that he built from the ground beginning in 2000. At MSU-Billings, Aumend has again taken a program from scratch and made it competitive in just a few years. The Yellowjackets won 18 of their last 24 games, last year, to finish just one game below .500 at 27-28. The 2004 season was full of highlights as they led the Pacific West Conference in home runs and had six players named all-conference with two of those also being named all-region. A 53-92 overall record for the program is deceptive as the Jackets have increased, progressively, from 2 wins in 2001 to 9 (2002), 15 (2003) and 27, last season.

Aumend, a native of Alliance, Ohio, started the NCAA Division II women's softball program at Queens College in Charlotte, North Carolina in 1994 and served as its first and only Head Women's Softball Coach until he moved to Billings in September of 2000 to start the MSU-Billings softball program. In his seven years at Queens College, Aumend achieved a 155-132 record with a 100% graduation rate among his student-athletes. In Aumend's first season at Queens College (1993-94), the Royals posted a 26-17 record. More recently, in the 1997 season, the Royals went 32-13 and finished the season ranked fourth in the South Atlantic Region. Aumend earned his 200th career victory last season and has an eleven-year career record of 208-224. A respected hitting coach, his 1998 team at Queens finished fourth in the nation in team batting average at .372 and last year's MSU-Billings finished 23rd in the nation home runs with 32.

MSU-Billings competes in the Pacific West Conference, which includes four schools in Hawaii and one in New Mexico. MSU-Billings is the first four-year institution in Montana to offer women's softball. Aumend received a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication Arts from Defiance College (Ohio). He currently serves on the NCAA Division II "Top 25" poll committee and is the former National Chairperson for Education/Publications for the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).
