This Week's Opponents:

Western Washington University - MSUB kicks off the Easton Tournament against the struggling Vikings. At 4-10, WWU is trying to snap a five game losing streak. Megan McPhee has been a bright spot, hitting .400 with a .667 slugging percentage.

Central Washington University - The Wildcats edged the Jackets 1-0 at the Central Washington Invite earlier in March. Since then they have built a 10-10 record. After losing their first seven games of the season, they Wildcats have won 10 of their last 13. Patty Martinez is batting .326 with 14 RBI and four home runs. Sara Badgley has struck out 86 and posted a 1.68 ERA in 58 innings.

Brandi Harrison and Nancy Harbeson are each batting over .400. Tracy Motany and Lissy Prescott are a combined 16-1 with 0.55 and 1.14 ERAs respectively.

Drought, What Drought?:

Notes

While those in the Montana and the Pacific Northwest lament another year of extreme drought, softball teams in Hawaii and California are struggling to play through the rain. The Yellowjackets had a window of three days to get in four games at Hawaii Pacific late last week, but were able to play just two games on Thursday before spending Friday and Saturday sitting on their hands. The Jackets were able to get in a pair of games at BYU-Hawaii on Monday, winning both. On Tuesday, the Jackets and Seasiders dodged early morning rain showers and split a doubleheader. MSUB dropped a heartbreaker in game one, 7-6, after allowing five runs in the bottom of the seventh. The Jackets erupted for 16 runs in the second game to win in a shootout, 16-11, improving to 3-3 in the conference. From rain-soaked Hawaii, the Jackets fly to rain-soaked California for the Easton Tournament of Champions in Modesto.

Soup's On:

Drought described Theresa Campbell's junior campaign last year. "Soup" batted just .187 with four home runs in 54 games. The 2005 season has been a different story. The senior from Great Falls is fifth on the team with a .321 batting average and has already matched last season's home run total. She will be in a race the rest of the season with fellow senior Layne Pavey for the school record for career home runs. Pavey currently has 16 dingers while Campbell is close behind with 12.

500 Fans:

Can it be called the "500 Club" if there is only one member? Either way, Joey Ehnes became the first pitcher in school history to eclipse 500 career strikeouts, reaching 512 this week. The senior from Great Falls already holds every school pitching record and has just over half a season left to add to her totals. She has fanned 144 in 118 innings this season. Last year she set the single season record with 261 Ks.

To Be or Not To Be Ranked:

The first NCAA regional softball rankings are scheduled to be released Wednesday afternoon. Based on their 9-3 record on a West Coast swing earlier this month, the Yellowjackets have a legitimate argument to be ranked in the region's top ten. MSU-Billings has never achieved a regional ranking in softball. Wednesday's ranking by the NCAA Softball Committee will list the top ten teams in the region in alphabetical order. The next regional ranking—released on April 6—will rank the teams in numerical order. The top six teams in each region are invited to the NCAA Tournament. The Yellowjackets could also earn a tournament berth by winning the PacWest title.

But You'll Have to Earn It:

If the Yellowjackets do earn their first-ever trip to the NCAA Tourney, they'll know they've earned it. The scheduling gurus at both the Central Washington Invitational and this week's Easton Tournament of Champions didn't give MSUB a free pass. The Jackets will face fourth-ranked Humboldt State at the Easton Tourney...again. The Yellowjackets and Lumberjacks have been paired at both tournaments over the past couple seasons. MSUB almost shocked the Jacks a few weeks ago in Richland before losing 1-0. A win this week in Modesto would catapult the Jackets into the regional tournament mix in a hurry.

Yellowjacket Coaching Staff



Jeff Aumend is in his fifth season at the helm of the Yellowjacket program that he built from the ground beginning in 2000. At MSU-Billings, Aumend has again taken a program from scratch and made it competitive in just a few years. The Yellowjackets won 18 of their last 24 games, last year, to finish just one game below .500 at 27-28. The 2004 season was full of highlights as they led the Pacific West Conference in home runs and had six players named all-conference with two of those also being named all-region. A 53-92 overall record for the program is deceptive as the Jackets have increased, progressively, from 2 wins in 2001 to 9 (2002), 15 (2003) and 27, last season.

Aumend, a native of Alliance, Ohio, started the NCAA Division II women's softball program at Queens College in Charlotte, North Carolina in 1994 and served as its first and only Head Women's Softball Coach until he moved to Billings in September of 2000 to start the MSU-Billings softball program. In his

seven years at Queens College, Aumend achieved a 155-132 record with a 100% graduation rate among his student-athletes. In Aumend's first season at Queens College (1993-94), the Royals posted a 26-17 record. More recently, in the 1997 season, the Royals went 32-13 and finished the season ranked fourth in the South Atlantic Region. Aumend earned his 200th career victory last season and has an eleven-year career record of 208-224. A respected hitting coach, his 1998 team at Queens finished fourth in the nation in team batting average at .372 and last year's MSU-Billings finished 23rd in the nation home runs with 32.

MSU-Billings competes in the Pacific West Conference, which includes four schools in Hawaii and one in New Mexico. MSU-Billings is the first four-year institution in Montana to offer women's softball. Aumend received a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication Arts from Defiance College (Ohio).
