This Week's Opponents:

<u>Chaminade University</u> – The Silverswords are 9-26 overall and 2-6 in the PacWest. They started 1-9 with their first win coming in an upset of first place Hawaii-Hilo in February. CU had a stretch in the middle of the season when they went 8-11, but the Swords have dropped 11 of their last twelve games.

Despite the losing record, the Silverswords have some dangerous offensive weapons with four players hitting over .300. Tara Hiramatsu is batting a team-best .344 for the season. She also leads the team with 22 runs. Pua Reis is batting .343 with 18 RBI and seven home runs. Heidi Garcia is hitting .306 with 11 RBI. Kehaulani Yamaguchi is batting .303 with 18 runs.

Donnell Wittekind is Chaminade's top pitcher. She has thrown 98 innings this season with a 4.07 ERA. Natalie Alcala has tossed 46 innings with a 4.41 ERA.

<u>University of Hawaii-Hilo</u> – The Vulcans are in the driver's seat of the PacWest Conference. At 24-6 overall and 9-1 in the conference, they are currently the frontrunner for the PacWest title and its corresponding automatic NCAA Tournament berth. The Vulcans play four games at Western New Mexico before traveling to Billings for games on Sunday and Monday.

Leo Sing Chow, one of the top pitchers in the league as a freshman two years ago, leads the conference in batting with a .449 average and five home runs. She has also been solid on the mound with a 1.34 ERA in 57 innings. Lisa Jackson is batting .386 with a team-high 31 runs scored. Natalie Fujimoto leads the team with 26 RBI, followed by Sing Chow and Meghan Jost with 24 apiece.

Now They Really Count:

The Yellowjackets are having their best season in the program's history with a 20-10 overall record and first-ever regional ranking. But the next four weeks will determine whether they get their first invitation to the NCAA Tournament. Three PacWest teams will visit Billings for a total of 12 games during that span, including conference frontrunner Hawaii-Hilo. While MSU-Billings may still be in the running for an at large bid to the tournament, history says that the PacWest will only get one team in the six-team regional tourney field.

No Rest for the Weary:

When MSU-Billings and Chaminade lace up for PacWest Conference games on Tuesday and Wednesday, neither team is likely to feel rested. The Silverswords played six games in California last week, including four at the Easton Tournament of Champions. The Yellowjackets have been on the road since they left for Hawaii on March 22. The Swords had the benefit of not playing on Sunday at the Easton, giving them two days of rest. The Jackets, however, had to play into the tournament semifinals on Sunday. Making matters worse, because of problems with flight schedules the Yellowjackets won't arrive back in Billings until after 9:00 p.m. Monday night.

Seeing 'Jacks:

The Yellowjackets may be forgiven if they're having nightmares about Humboldt State. The fourth-ranked Lumberjacks are 40-1 overall and have won 28 straight-games....and the Jackets have seemed to draw them at both of the big West Coast tournaments this season. MSUB fell to Humboldt 1-0 at the Central Washington Tourney last month. In pool play at the Easton Tournament, the Yellowjackets led 2-1 in the top of the eighth before losing 3-2. MSUB was then paired with HSU in the semifinals of the Gold Bracket, losing 4-0 to the eventual tournament champions. The Jackets were 4-2 at the Easton, with both losses coming to Humboldt State.

All-Tourney Props:

MSUB senior Sara Hanley was the only Yellowjacket named to the Easton Tournament of Champions All-Tournament Team. She was also named the PacWest Co-Player of the Week on Monday. Hanley batted .529 at the tourney, going 9-for-17 with two runs and an RBI. Her hot hitting raised her career average by 10 points...pretty impressive for a player with 422 career at bats. Mysteriously, the Jackets' Joey Ehnes was left off the all-tourney team after going 4-2 with a 0.53 ERA and 32 strikeouts in 26 1/3 innings.

Let the Poll Watch Begin:

One of the most exciting things in Division II athletics is regionalization and the weekly regional polls that determine who goes to the NCAA Tournament. For the first time in the program's five year history the Yellowjackets are in the regional poll mix. MSUB was ranked in the West Region top ten last week for the first time ever. The first poll was an alphabetical listing of the top ten with the first numerical rankings scheduled to be released this week. The first poll included Cal State-Bakersfield, Cal State-Chico, Cal State-Dominguez Hills, Central Washington, Hawaii-Hilo, Humboldt State, MSU-Billings, San Francisco State, Seattle, and UC-San Diego.

Yellowjacket Coaching Staff



Jeff Aumend is in his fifth season at the helm of the Yellowjacket program that he built from the ground beginning in 2000. At MSU-Billings, Aumend has again taken a program from scratch and made it competitive in just a few years. The Yellowjackets won 18 of their last 24 games, last year, to finish just one game below .500 at 27-28. The 2004 season was full of highlights as they led the Pacific West Conference in home runs and had six players named all-conference with two of those also being named all-region. A 53-92 overall record for the program is deceptive as the Jackets have increased, progressively, from 2 wins in 2001 to 9 (2002), 15 (2003) and 27, last season.

Aumend, a native of Alliance, Ohio, started the NCAA Division II women's softball program at Queens College in Charlotte, North Carolina in 1994 and served as its first and only Head Women's Softball Coach until he moved to Billings in September of 2000 to start the MSU-Billings softball program. In his

seven years at Queens College, Aumend achieved a 155-132 record with a 100% graduation rate among his student-athletes. In Aumend's first season at Queens College (1993-94), the Royals posted a 26-17 record. More recently, in the 1997 season, the Royals went 32-13 and finished the season ranked fourth in the South Atlantic Region. Aumend earned his 200th career victory last season and has an eleven-year career record of 208-224. A respected hitting coach, his 1998 team at Queens finished fourth in the nation in team batting average at .372 and last year's MSU-Billings finished 23rd in the nation home runs with 32.

MSU-Billings competes in the Pacific West Conference, which includes four schools in Hawaii and one in New Mexico. MSU-Billings is the first four-year institution in Montana to offer women's softball. Aumend received a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication Arts from Defiance College (Ohio). He currently serves on the NCAA Division II "Top 25" poll committee and is the former National Chairperson for Education/Publications for the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).
