This Week's Opponent:

Western New Mexico University – The Mustangs are the defending PacWest and West Region champions, but are on the verge of being eliminated from playoff contention. With a 26-25 record entering the weekend, the Mustangs will likely be geared up for their final four regular season games in Billings. WNMU, ranked tenth in the most recent West Region poll, was 3-4 last weekend at the Bakersfield tournament but scored an upset of San Francisco State.

The Mustangs are a more dangerous team offensively than they were last year when they won their third straight PacWest title and captured the NCAA West Region crown. Last year they rode All-America pitcher Angela Slauch to 38 of their 45 wins. With a young pitching staff this year, they have had to score more runs to win. WNMU's team batting average is 36 points higher this season than it was last year. They have hit 17 more home runs in seven fewer games this year. And they have already scored 45 more runs than they did all of last season, including the tournament.

In all, six different Mustangs are batting over .300 for the season. Tiffany DeVours leads the team with a .360 batting average. She is second in the conference with 38 RBI and leads the league with 22 doubles. Meredith Drahota is hitting .351 and was named to the all-tournament team in Bakersfield. She leads the team with eight home runs and has scored 37 runs with 31 RBI.

Stephanie Kirkpatrick is hitting .347 and leads the team with 38 runs and 38 RBI. She also has seven home runs. Rachel Stahle is batting .329, Melissa Lundwell is hitting .302, and Jessica Garcia is hitting .301.

Freshman pitcher Molly Yetman has been a great addition for the Mustangs this season as they try to replace Slauch. The PacWest player of the week two weeks ago, she is 15-13 overall and ranks tenth in the league for ERA (3.16), tenth for opposing batting average (.273), second for innings pitched (170.2), third for strikeouts (116), and second for wins (15). Megan Gross is second in the PacWest with 131 strikeouts and also ranks in the conference's top ten for ERA, opposing batting average, wins, and innings pitched.

NCAA Poll Watch

The Jackets made a big jump in last week's NCAA West Region poll, moving up from No. 5 to No. 3. The top six teams in the region on May 9 will be invited to the NCAA Tournament. The 48 team tournament begins with eight six-team regional tournaments on May 12. The winners of the eight regionals advance to the elite eight. While there's no way to tell how close any of the teams are in the poll, the assumption is that Humboldt State is a lock at No. 1 and Cal State-Dominguez Hills has a solid hold on No. 2. The Jackets and San Francisco State appear to be in a tight battle for the third spot. The Gators had a big week, going 4-1 at the Bakersfield tournament and possibly earning enough points to regain the third spot this week. The next poll should be released on Wednesday. Sun Sets on the PacWest

The Yellowjackets and Mustangs will play the final games of the Pacific West Conference this weekend. Beginning next year both MSU-Billings and Western New Mexico will move to the Heartland Conference, leaving the PacWest two schools short of the minimum to be an NCAA Division II conference. While the Hawaii schools will no doubt continue to look for two new members to revive the PacWest in the future, Sunday's doubleheader at Cenex Stadium represents the final two PacWest contests in any sport. There's a chance that MSU-Billings and Hawaii-Hilo could meet at the NCAA Softball Tournament, but they would not be PacWest games. The Vulcans clinched the PacWest title last weekend with a sweep of Hawaii Pacific and will be the conference's automatic qualifier to the NCAA Tourney.

Four Years Boils Down to Four Games

At MSU-Billings we try not to over-hype any contest because our Mission is to create "positive and successful academic and athletic experiences" for our student-athletes. However, it's impossible to ignore the importance of this weekend's games at Cenex Stadium. A successful weekend will most likely give the Jackets their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in the program's short five year history. That's quite an accomplishment for a group of seniors who have been starters since they stepped on campus and endured that 9-17 freshman season, the 15-20 sophomore campaign, and thousands of miles of air and van travel. This weekend they have the chance to say they put MSU-Billings Softball on the map. As they've reached that goal over the last four years, this group of Yellowjackets has given all of us the great experiences and memories that we hope they too take away from Montana State University-Billings.

Yellowjacket Coaching Staff



Jeff Aumend is in his fifth season at the helm of the Yellowjacket program that he built from the ground beginning in 2000. At MSU-Billings, Aumend has again taken a program from scratch and made it competitive in just a few years. The Yellowjackets won 18 of their last 24 games, last year, to finish just one game below .500 at 27-28. The 2004 season was full of highlights as they led the Pacific West Conference in home runs and had six players named all-conference with two of those also being named all-region. A 53-92 overall record for the program is deceptive as the Jackets have increased, progressively, from 2 wins in 2001 to 9 (2002), 15 (2003) and 27, last season.

Aumend, a native of Alliance, Ohio, started the NCAA Division II women's softball program at Queens College in Charlotte, North Carolina in 1994 and served as its first and only Head Women's Softball Coach until he moved to Billings in September of 2000 to start the MSU-Billings softball program. In his seven years at Queens College, Aumend achieved a 155-132 record with a 100% graduation rate among his student-athletes. In Aumend's first season at Queens College (1993-94), the Royals posted a 26-17 record. More recently, in the 1997 season, the Royals went 32-13 and finished the season ranked fourth in the South Atlantic Region. Aumend earned his 200th career victory last season and has an eleven-year career record of 208-224. A respected hitting coach, his 1998 team at Queens finished fourth in the nation in team batting average at .372 and last year's MSU-Billings finished 23rd in the nation home runs with 32.

MSU-Billings competes in the Pacific West Conference, which includes four schools in Hawaii and one in New Mexico. MSU-Billings is the first four-year institution in Montana to offer women's softball. Aumend received a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication Arts from Defiance College (Ohio). He currently serves on the NCAA Division II "Top 25" poll committee and is the former National Chairperson for Education/Publications for the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).
