### Week in Review:

The Yellowjackets were idle last week after a 12-game swing to Phoenix to open the season. They went 4-8 on the trip with wins over Western New Mexico, Cal State-Bakersfield, Western Oregon, and Grand Canyon. After starting the Schutt Sports DII Leadoff Classic with back-to-back losses, the Jackets won three in a row to advance to the Bronze Bracket championship game where they lost 3-0 to Missouri Western State. During the 12-game trip, sophomore Terina Stacks was 15-for-44 for a .341 average. She had nine RBIs, seven runs scored, three doubles, and two home runs. Lorel Palmer batted .306 for the week with four runs scored. Steph Gosselin scored five times. Pitcher Lisa Moore was 1-3 with a 4.48 ERA. Her win came in an extra innings affair against Cal State-Bakersfield. Stacks was 2-1 with a 7.37 ERA. Lindsey Trenary saw her first collegiate action, going 0-1 with a 7.58 ERA. Rebekah Tsatsa was 1-3 with a 7.61 ERA.

### Extra Innings:

After an opening day split with Western New Mexico, the Jackets lost their next six games to start the season 1-7. The offense was as much to blame as anything. In those first eight games, MSUB scored a total of 17 runs with 45 hits. In the three-game winning streak that followed, the Jackets totaled 22 runs and 27 hits....Sophomore Lisa Moore from Bakersfield, Calif., pitched her best game of the season in an eight inning 2-1 win over Cal State-Bakersfield. She scattered six hits over eight innings, giving up just one unearned run....Terina Stacks, who batted .167 in only 36 at bats last year, hit .341 in 44 at bats in the opening week. She was named Heartland Conference Hitter of the Week for her performance. Batting from the leadoff spot, Stacks led the team with nine RBIs and seven runs.

### **Yellowjacket Softball Staff**



Kim Lemmens was hired as the third head softball coach in school history on May 30, 2006. Most recently Lemmens was the first assistant coach at Fort Hays State University in Hays, Kansas. Before her one season at Fort Hays State, Lemmens was the pitching coach at Colorado State University for four years. At CSU, Lemmens helped two pitchers earn All-Mountain West honors. The Rams won two Mountain West titles during Lemmens's four years with the program. Lemmens is originally from Denmark, Wisconsin. She was a pitcher for four years at University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, an NCAA Division III school. She helped Wisconsin-Whitewater to two conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.



Cori Thiermann is in her first season as an assistant coach at MSU-Billings. She is a 2006 graduate of University of Wisconsin-Green Bay where she was a varsity letter winner from 2002 to 2005. Last year she was a student assistant coach at UW-Green Bay. As a senior Thiermann batted .224 in 31 games to help the Phoenix win the Horizon League title and advance to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in school history. UW-Green Bay upset sixth-ranked Oregon State in the first round of that tournament for its first-ever win over a ranked opponent.
