University of Mary

The Marauders are making a stop in Billings for Wednesday's double-header after playing 11 games in Tucson between February 26 and March 4. They were 7-4 on the trip and bring an 11-5 record to Billings. Mary has won five games in a row and six of its last seven. During the five-game winning streak, they have averaged 9.2 runs per game. No individual stats are available for the Marauders.

Lincoln University

The Blue Tigers are 3-3 entering the week. They will play at Missouri-Rolla on Tuesday before hosting the Yellowjackets on Friday and Saturday. The weekend series will be the Heartland Conference opener for both the Tigers and Yellowjackets. Lincoln is picked to finish sixth in the six-team Heartland; MSU-Billings is picked to finish fourth.

The Blue Tigers have two wins over Southwest Baptist and a double-header split with Newman. They were swept by fifth-ranked Southern Illinois-Edwardsville. Despite being shutout in two of their three losses, the Tigers are averaging 3.3 runs per game and have hit four home runs in six games.

Lincoln lists a dozen players on its roster, but only nine players have seen action this season. Ashley Prenger and Abby Stuenkel are each hitting over .300. Prenger leads the team with a .353 average, and Stuenkel is hitting .313. Stuenkel has two of the team's four home runs and boasts a .688 slugging percentage. Nikki Nelke has pitched all 38 innings for the Blue Tigers this season. She has a 4.24 ERA with 22 strikeouts against 16 walks. Last season when the Tigers played the Jackets in Billings, Tracy Reyland pitched all but 1/3 of an inning in the four games. Nelke pitched that other 1/3 inning.

Week in Review:

The Yellowjackets were 5-3 at the Central Washington Invitational last weekend. They defeated Northwest Nazarene, Western Oregon (twice), Western Washington, and Saint Martin's. The losses came to Central Washington and Seattle (twice). MSUB lost to Seattle 2-1 in the semifinals of bracket play. Seattle went on to defeat Central Washington for the tournament title.

Terina Stacks and Lorel Palmer each batted an identical .414 for the tournament, going 12-for-29 at the plate. Stacks drove in nine RBIs, scored seven runs, and hit two home runs and three doubles. She led the team in each of those categories as well as slugging percentage (.793). Palmer was MSUB's nominee for Heartland player of the week for tying the single game school record for hits twice. She was 4-for-5 against Saint Martin's and 4-for-4 against Western Oregon. Jessica Frank, Steph Gosselin, and Aysha Maddox each hit over .330 for the tourney. Rebekah Tsatsa went 2-for-2 with a 1.96 ERA in four starts, striking out 16.

Extra Innings:

The difference in the Jackets' 4-8 start and their 5-3 run at the Central Washington Invitational may have been the bats. In the first 12 games of the season, MSUB hit a combined .244 with a slugging percentage of .290. In the eight games in Washington, the Jackets hit .295 as a team with a .402 slugging percentage....The Yellowjacket pitching showed marked improvement last week as well, although it did benefit from solid run production. The four Yellowjacket pitchers had a combined ERA of 2.64 at last week's tournament even though they're still being bit by walks, averaging .54 per inning. The coaches would also like to see the defense behind their pitchers stiffen a little. The Jackets have committed 31 errors in 20 games, ranking them next to last in the Heartland with a .949 fielding percentage....Just 20 games into the season, Jessica Frank has already broken the single season school record for stolen bases. Granted, the Yellowjackets have never been much of a running team, but Frank has swiped seven of eight attempts so far....What a difference a year has made for sophomore Terina Stacks. Last year she batted .167. This year she is hitting a team-best .370 with almost as many hits (27) as she had at-bats last year (36). She leads the team in home runs, doubles, runs, RBI, and slugging percentage.

Kim Lemmens was hired as the third head softball coach in school history on May 30, 2006. Most recently Lemmens was the first assistant coach at Fort Hays State University in Hays, Kansas. Before her one season at Fort Hays State, Lemmens was the pitching coach at Colorado State University for four years. At CSU, Lemmens helped two pitchers earn All-Mountain West honors. The Rams won two Mountain West titles during Lemmens's four years with the program. Lemmens is originally from Denmark, Wisconsin. She was a pitcher for four years at University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, an NCAA Division III school. She helped Wisconsin-Whitewater to two conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.



Cori Thiermann is in her first season as an assistant coach at MSU-Billings. She is a 2006 graduate of University of Wisconsin-Green Bay where she was a varsity letter winner from 2002 to 2005. Last year she was a student assistant coach at UW-Green Bay. As a senior Thiermann batted .224 in 31 games to help the Phoenix win the Horizon League title and advance to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in school history. UW-Green Bay upset sixth-ranked Oregon State in the first round of that tournament for its first-ever win over a ranked opponent.
