## Oklahoma Panhandle State University

The Aggies started the season with 16-straight losses before sweeping a pair of games at Texas-Permian Basin last weekend. Entering the series with the Falcons, the Aggies had been outscored 135-32 in their first 16 games. They turned the tables on UTPB, winning 9-1 and 10-1. The second day's games were rained out.

Despite the lack of run production as a team, the Aggies have three players batting over .300. Stacey Harbour leads the team and ranks second in the Heartland Conference with a . 375 average. She has four doubles and has scored seven times. Roxanna Palacios is hitting .314, and Krystal Comeaux is batting .306. Both have eight RBIs and five runs. Cathy Daza has scored 12 of the team's 51 runs and has five extra base hits. Rachael Hughes and Teena Joos have combined for 94 of the team's 99 innings. Hughes is $1-9$ with a 6.39 ERA. Joos is $1-7$ with an 11.36 ERA.

## West Texas A\&M University Lady Buffs

The Lady Buffs were picked to finish last in the South Division of the Lone Star Conference. They enter the week with a 5-19 overall record and a 10-game losing streak. WTAMU will have a busy week before they host the Yellowjackets next Monday. The Buffs play eight games in five days, all on the road.

Despite their record, the Lady Buffs’ offense has been able to score runs at times. Three players are batting over . 350 and the team is hitting a combined .277. Brooke Guidry's 392 average leads the way. She has a team-best 10 doubles and 21 RBIs. Kelsi Jensen is hitting .377 with 14 runs and 13 RBIs. Breanna Adams bats .359 and leads the team with 17 runs. The Buffs have struggled on the defensive side of the ball, giving up an average of eight runs per game including 10 or more in nine games. They were hammered for 21 runs by Angelo State last week. WTAMU uses four pitchers who have a combined ERA of 6.06. Sondi Giles and Kelsi Frost have logged the most innings with 40+ each.

## Week in Review:

The Yellowjackets had an up and down week, going 2-3 overall and 2-1 in conference games. They were swept at home on Wednesday by University of Mary, 5-4 and 5-3. In the first game, the Jackets scored in the bottom of the seventh to force extra innings, but gave up an eighth inning home run. Terina Stacks was 2-for-4 with a two-run home run in the top of the eighth. In the second game, the Jackets led until the fifth inning when another three-run home run cost them. The MSUB offense had six singles in the game.

The Jackets opened their Heartland Conference schedule on Friday at Lincoln University, but the day was rained out in the third inning of the first game with MSUB trailing 2-0. That game was resumed Saturday morning with neither team scoring for a 2-0 Tigers win. The Jackets rebounded to take the next two games, 7-0 and 7-3. Stacks was the winner in the first game, scattering three hits over seven innings. Jenna Haacke and Jenna McCartney each went 3-for-4 with a run and an RBI. Rebekah Tsatsa went the distance in the second game for her fourth win. Tsatsa, Jessica Frank, and Leslie Davis each had two hits in the game. Haacke drove in two runs.

## Extra Innings:

The Yellowjackets are above .500 in the conference for the first time since the end of the 2005 season when they finished 13-5 in the PacWest. Last year they lost their first nine Heartland games before winning 12 of their last 15 to finish 12$12 \ldots$. Wednesday's doubleheader against Mary was the earliest home game (March 7) ever played at Cenex Stadium, and it was probably the best weather the Jackets have ever had for a home opener. Unfortunately, the doubleheader sweep was also the first time MSUB lost a home opener in the program's six seasons ...In Rebekah Tsatsa's complete game victory at Lincoln on Saturday, she had the best offensive performance of her career, posting career highs for hits (2), runs (1), and RBI (1)....Speaking of helping her own cause, in Terina Stacks’ seven starts this season (4-3 record), she is batting . 440 with four doubles, two home runs, seven runs, six RBIs, and an .840 slugging percentage. Of course, she hasn't exactly been slacking in her other 18 games in the field: . 344 batting average, four doubles, three home runs, a triple, 14 RBIs, and a .578 slugging percentage....Stacks ranks third in the conference for batting average and hits, but the conference ranks players by total hits. If players were ranked by hits per game, Stacks would easily lead the Heartland at 1.32 hits per game.

## Yellowjacket Softball Staff



Kim Lemmens was hired as the third head softball coach in school history on May 30, 2006. Most recently Lemmens was the first assistant coach at Fort Hays State University in Hays, Kansas. Before her one season at Fort Hays State, Lemmens was the pitching coach at Colorado State University for four years. At CSU, Lemmens helped two pitchers earn All-Mountain West honors. The Rams won two Mountain West titles during Lemmens's four years with the program. Lemmens is originally from Denmark, Wisconsin. She was a pitcher for four years at University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, an NCAA Division III school. She helped Wisconsin-Whitewater to two conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.


Cori Thiermann is in her first season as an assistant coach at MSU-Billings. She is a 2006 graduate of University of Wisconsin-Green Bay where she was a varsity letter winner from 2002 to 2005. Last year she was a student assistant coach at UW-Green Bay. As a senior Thiermann batted .224 in 31 games to help the Phoenix win the Horizon League title and advance to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in school history. UW-Green Bay upset sixth-ranked Oregon State in the first round of that tournament for its first-ever win over a ranked opponent.
