St. Edward's University

The Hilltoppers moved into the NFCA Top 25 last week, debuting at No. 21. It is the first time St. Edward's has ever been nationally ranked in softball. They followed Wednesday's rankings announcement by taking three of four games from conference rival St. Mary's over the weekend.

After starting the season 6-11, St. Ed's will enter the weekend series with the Yellowjackets with a 27-14 overall record and a 7-1 mark in the Heartland Conference. Since their slow start, the Hilltoppers beat Emporia State (currently ranked seventh in the nation), and they won three of four games against Angelo State (currently ranked third in the nation).

The Hilltoppers lead all Heartland Conference teams in run production, scoring 188 times in 41 games (4.6 per game). They have hit twice as many home runs as their opponents and are 17-3 when they hit at least one home run. Eight different Hilltoppers have hit at least one home run this season.

Rebecca Ray leads the team and ranks 13th in the conference for batting average at .328. She has hit eight home runs and driven in 32 RBIs in 41 games. Her .490 slugging percentage ranks fourth in the league. Jennifer Hollas is hitting .309 and is 11-for-12 on stolen base attempts. Mandy Phillips has swiped a league-high 15 bases on 17 attempts.

The Toppers use a three-pitcher rotation with Jennifer Bishop and Courtney Francis logging a majority of the innings. Bishop is 11-7 with a 1.62 ERA in 22 appearances. Francis is 12-4 with a 2.37 ERA.

Week in Review:

The Yellowjackets won four of six games on the road last week, and all four wins were conference wins. They swept Oklahoma Panhandle State on Saturday and Sunday to improve to 6-1 in the conference before dropping a non-conference doubleheader at West Texas A&M on Monday.

The series sweep of Oklahoma Panhandle was the second time in the last two years that the Yellowjackets swept four games from the Aggies. After winning 8-6 and 10-2 on Saturday, the Jackets had to go into extra innings in both of Sunday's games for the sweep. They won 7-6 in eight innings and 3-2 in nine innings. Jessica Frank batted .615 in the four games with five RBIs and three runs. She doubled in all four games and had a slugging percentage of .923. Terina Stacks hit .533 for the series with four runs, three RBIs, and three doubles. Leslie Davis led the team with six runs in four games and hit the only home run of the series. Rebekah Tsatsa went 2-0 with a 1.70 ERA in two appearances. Stacks and Lindsey Trenary earned the other wins.

After averaging seven runs a game in the OPSU series, the Jackets managed just three runs in the two losses to WTAMU. They fell behind early in the first game and lost 6-3. Despite out-hitting the Buffs 7-4 in the second game, they lost 1-0. Stacks and Jenna McCartney were the only two to hit safely in both games.

Extra Innings:

The Jackets were double trouble for Oklahoma Panhandle State over the weekend, hitting 14 doubles in four games. In their other 28 games this season MSUB has 23 doubles. Jessica Frank and Terina Stacks accounted for half of the 14 doubles at OPSU and have combined for 19 doubles this season....Sophomore Leslie Davis has been becoming more productive as the season has gone on. She had one of her best weekends last week, batting .357 against OPSU. She scored six times and drove in another four runs. She also hit her second home run of the season....In the Heartland preseason coaches' poll, the Yellowjackets were picked to finish fourth. They have put themselves in position to do at least that in the past two weeks, going 6-1 against the two teams picked below them in the poll....Before this season, a total of four players were tied for the school record for hits in a game at four. That has been matched three times already this season. Lorel Palmer did it twice at the Central Washington Invitational, and Frank did it by going 4-for-4 last Sunday at OPSU. Frank has now inked her name in the school record books twice this year having already broken the single season stolen bases record.

Kim Lemmens was hired as the third head softball coach in school history on May 30, 2006. Most recently Lemmens was the first assistant coach at Fort Hays State University in Hays, Kansas. Before her one season at Fort Hays State, Lemmens was the pitching coach at Colorado State University for four years. At CSU, Lemmens helped two pitchers earn All-Mountain West honors. The Rams won two Mountain West titles during Lemmens's four years with the program. Lemmens is originally from Denmark, Wisconsin. She was a pitcher for four years at University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, an NCAA Division III school. She helped Wisconsin-Whitewater to two conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.



Cori Thiermann is in her first season as an assistant coach at MSU-Billings. She is a 2006 graduate of University of Wisconsin-Green Bay where she was a varsity letter winner from 2002 to 2005. Last year she was a student assistant coach at UW-Green Bay. As a senior Thiermann batted .224 in 31 games to help the Phoenix win the Horizon League title and advance to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in school history. UW-Green Bay upset sixth-ranked Oregon State in the first round of that tournament for its first-ever win over a ranked opponent.
